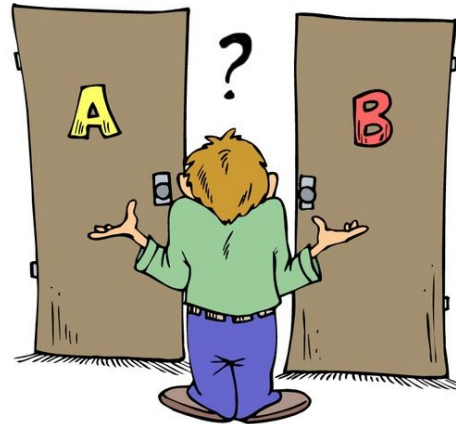

What the Players Get	Recreational	ATP
Coach	Volunteer Coach	USSF F License Minimum or United Soccer Coaches (USC) Level 1 Diploma plus continued in-house education
Season Length	10 weeks per season (late Aug.- early Nov.) (March – May)	14-16 weeks per season (early Aug – mid Nov.) (mid Jan – May)
Weekly Practice Days	2 per week (bi-weekly staff session)	3 per week
<i>Approximate</i> Contact Days Per Season (days w/coach depending on team calendar)	20-30 days per season	45-65 days per season
Player Commitment	Season to Season	Year (Aug-May)

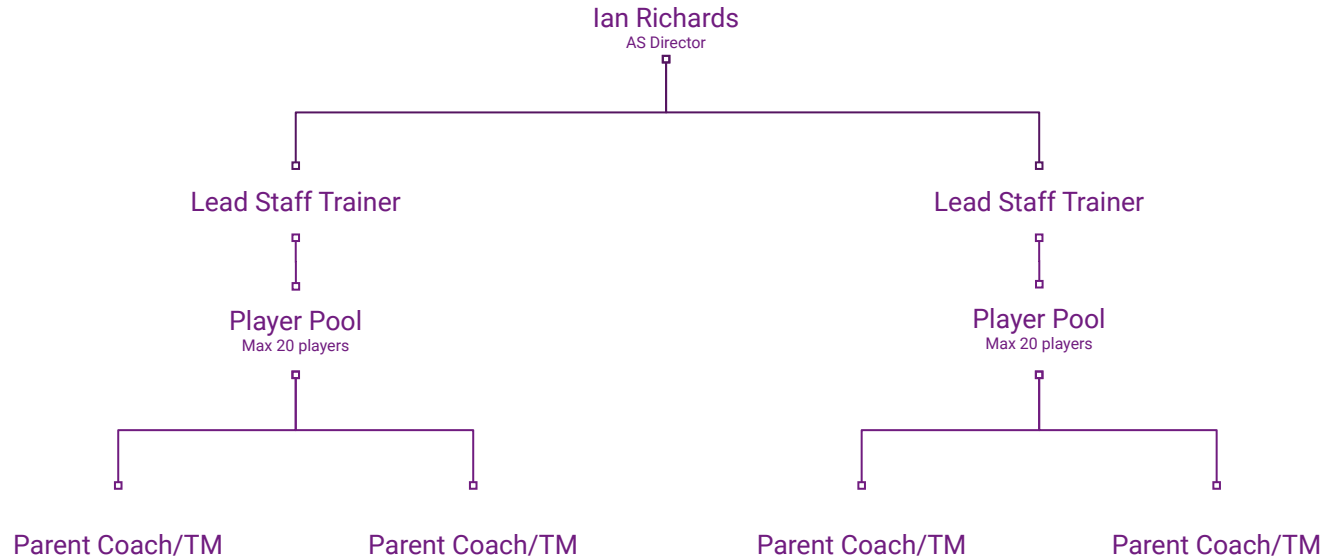

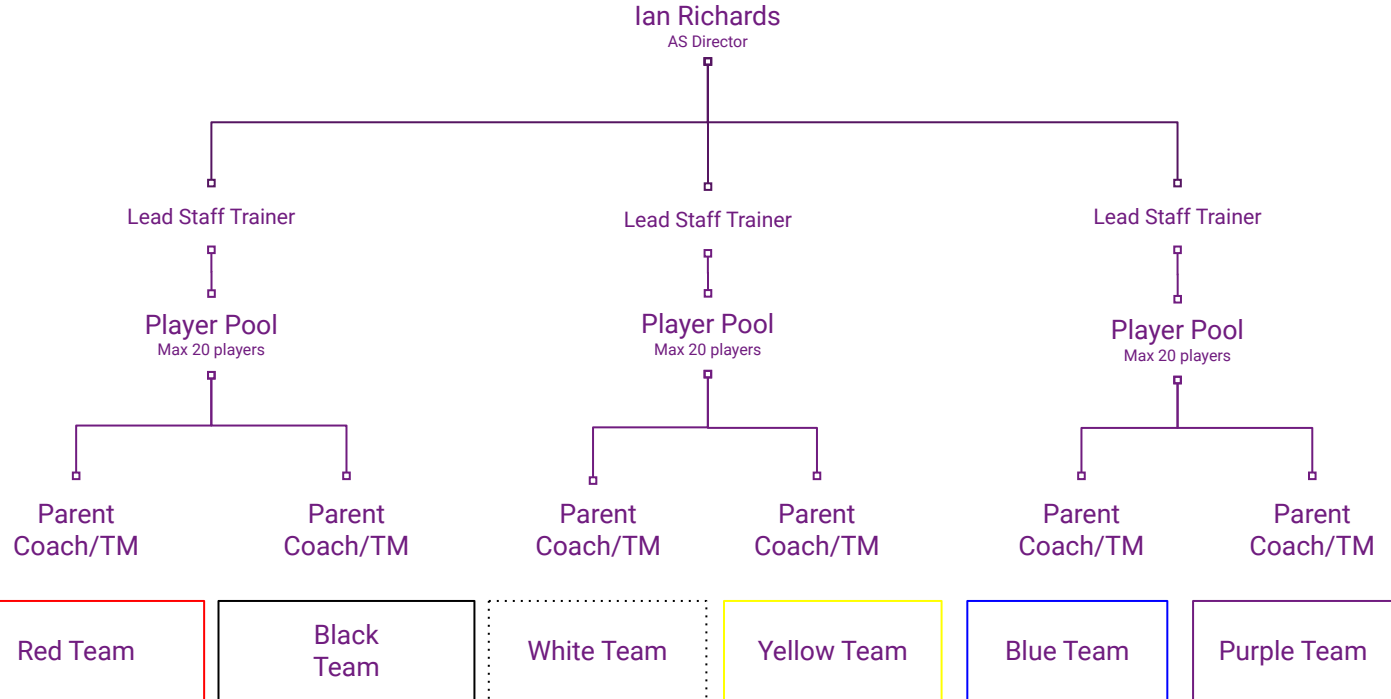

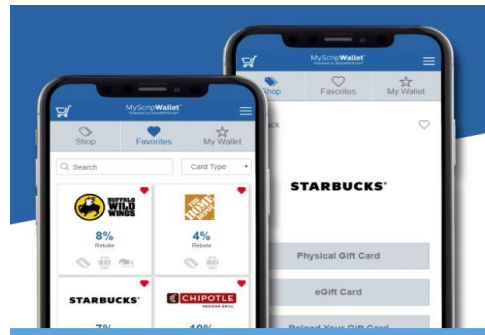
Practices begin once fields have been opened
