

## **MMYFC LEAGUE MANDATORY PAPERWORK**

*The medical release form and the participation form are attached or may be downloaded from our web site at [www.hcterps.org](http://www.hcterps.org) (forms).*

*For your convenience we will collect medical, participation, and player and parent code of conduct forms at Parent Orientation and all equipment distributions. If you do not have all items, please keep them and turn in at practice field on the first day. These are needed for Football and Cheer.*

- **Medical Release Form** : *This form needs to be provided on the first day your child will practice* It must be signed by child's doctor in the current year- no child will be allowed to practice without this form on file. Form must be given to the Director of Team Administration, during Parent Orientation, Equipment distribution or at the first practice. A representative will be located at the practice field table at East Columbia Library most days from 6:00pm -7pm.
- **Participant Information Form** – must be filled out completely and signed – no child will be allowed to practice without this form on file.
- **Code of conduct form player and parent**: required that each parent and athlete understands the importance of and consequences of not having good sportsmanship. Parents are signing for the family and should inform any guest they invite of our code of conduct rules.
- **Maryland State Identification Card** (MVA) or MMYFCL ID Card- We must have an ID for your player or cheerleader. Obtain this at your local Motor Vehicle Admin. Allow two weeks for processing. ID card will be sent to your home address. Child and parent/guardian must be present for photo and must present an original birth certificate and SSN card. For those that cannot obtain a MVA ID, the league will make a card during certification in August. See your coach for details. Child will not be allowed to play (not exceptions) without either a MVA card or MMYFCL ID card. For more information about MVA ID go online to: <http://www.marylandmva.com/DriverServ/Apply/id.htm>. IDs will be given to the head coach and or team admin (team mom or dad) prior to roster certification. ID cards will be held by the organization during the entire season and will be presented at every game day during the weigh-in procedures. Parents are responsible for getting their child's ID from the coach or team mom at the players last game.

*(To obtain a MMYFCL ID: **Only if you cannot obtain a MVA ID.** A MMYFCL ID is required, along with original birth certificate, one other form of identification such as school record with date of birth on it, and fee. Child must be present for picture. Dates and locations for obtaining the MMYFCL ID will be provided the first weeks of August.*
