



# **ESU Sport Camps and Clinics 2021**

## **Policies and Procedures**

Dear Parents,

Thank you for your interest in the sports camps and clinics at East Stroudsburg University. To ensure the health and safety of all involved, there have been changes to the operations of our camps and clinics to align with CDC and PA Dept. of Health COVID-19 Guidelines. Please review the below information below.

### **Items to Bring**

In addition to what is required for their sport (cleats, bat, sticks, etc.) we ask that campers also bring the following:

- A cloth or surgical facemask.
- An adequate amount of water.
  - ESU will not be supplying a communal water source.
- Snacks or a bagged lunch.

### **COVID-19 Mitigation**

- Hand sanitizing stations will be available at every camp.
- Shared equipment will be sanitized regularly.
- Whenever possible, social distancing of at least 6 feet should be followed and campers should stay in their designated pods.
- All individuals not participating in on field activities must wear a mask.
- Only those participating in action on the field may remove their masks; however, they must have a method of masking available that must be applied during time-outs and team meetings.

### **Pre-Screening Procedures**

- Prior to arrival, the parent/guardian will be forwarded a link to a COVID-19 Screening questionnaire. The day of the scheduled event, the questionnaire must be filled out. If the COVID-19 Screening is not completed, they will not be permitted entry into the venue.

### Drop Off/Pick Up

Each camp will have a specific drop off and pick up instructions based on location. This allows for medical staff to perform a temperature check on each child while there is still a parent/guardian available. An individual with a temperature equal to or greater than 100.4° will not be permitted entry into the venue.

- Whitenight: medical check-in at field entrance, driver can proceed along Whitenight Field fence to parking area, turn around, and exit.
- Creekview Park: medical check-in at driveway gate, driver can then proceed to parking lot, turn around, and exit park.
- Koehler Fieldhouse: medical check-in at the Smith Street parking lot (across from Fieldhouse), driver can loop around and exit lot.
- Eiler-Martin Stadium: medical check-in at stadium gate entrance, driver can loop around and exit lot.

### Spectators

- For safety reason, at this time we cannot allow spectators in the venues. We ask that you leave campus after dropping off your camper.

### Illness

- In the event that a camper begins to exhibit symptoms of illness, that individual will be removed from the venue and their emergency contact will be notified to come and pick them up. The camper will be isolated from the rest of the campers but will not be left alone until their ride has arrived.
- In the event that a camper tests positive for COVID-19 within 48 hours of participating in a camp, all participants of the camp will be made aware.
