

These assessment guidelines were written and reviewed by the LVGSA board in their dedication to distribute talent evenly and to keep Fair Play for all. These rules are not intended to give any manager leverage. Rules apply to all managers, coaches, and players

- Assessment day schedule below:
 - o 8am 14U
 - o 9am 12U
 - o 10am 10U
 - o 11am 8U
 - o 12pm 6U
- We ask players to show up 1 hour early to check in, pick uniform sizes and warm up.
- A player may assess to play up a division. The player playing up must be drafted by a manager. No hat
 picks can play up. If a player playing up is not drafted, they will be placed in their age-appropriate
 division draft.
- No player can play down in a division without approval from the player agent, division commissioner and president.
- We will have registration and uniform tables set up next to men's room and snack bar.
- Assessments will be on Rivera field (pitching and catching assessment will be on North field at the end of each age groups assessment.)
- Anyone that does not assess will be a hat pick
 - o Hat picks cannot coach block or make requests to play with other players
- Warm up area is on North outfield area. No other areas will be available
- Any coach blocks or request must be made in writing to the player agent by the end of assessments.
 - o If you request a coach block you must have a compelling reason for the block.
 - The player agent will decide if the coach block is valid
- Commissioner of each division will assess their division players to help with draft process.
- Coach locks must be made in writing at assessments to the player agent.
- After each assessment player agent, division commissioner and managers will meet and discuss the following:
 - Coach locks any concerns
 - Draft details date, time, and place
 - Safety concerns

Assessment Drills

The girls will be assessed on the following drills:

- 1. Pop Flys (12U 8U) Catch three pop flys
- 2. Ground Balls (12U 6U) Catch three ground balls and throw to 1st base from short stop. 6U will throw to pitcher.
- 3. 1st Base (12U 6U) Catch 3 balls at 1st base. 6U will catch at pitcher
- 4. Hitting (12U 6U) Hit 5 coach pitched balls. 6U will have 3 coach pitch then one-off tee.
- 5. Running (12U 6U) Run home to 1st and 1st to 3rd
- 6. Pitchers (12U 8U) Pitch 10 pitches to a catcher
- 7. Catchers (12 8U) Catch 10 pitches. Last two pitches throw to 2^{nd} base
