The League is looking for groups to come out to a game and cheer for the athletes during their game. Adopt-a-Teams can be any group of people (church groups, Little League/Select Baseball or Softball Teams, family and friends, companies,



girl/boy scout troops, etc.) that come and cheer one of the Challenger games.

## What does adopting a team require?

- A 1-1.5 hour commitment one Saturday, morning or evening, between April 29 and July 1 to cheer for our athletes.
  - Adopt-a-Teams will cheer for both teams from center field.
  - Games will be played at Heritage Oak Park and Cottell Park.
- Provide a drink and prepackaged snack for the players of both teams after the game.
- Please arrive 10 minutes prior to the game for opening welcome.
- Groups have the option to provide goodie bags with additional snacks, baseball themed items, stickers, water bottles, vouchers to local establishments or any combination of items. Groups have also made personalized signs for each team player. While none of these are required for you to participate, we promise you have never met a more appreciative group of athletes.
