

## 2021 BBL Covid-19 Policies

Dear Brookhaven Basketball Families,

We are still feeling some of the effects of the lingering pandemic and hope that you and your family are staying healthy. We have gathered a lot of information and discussed multiple options to move forward, however, there is no easy solution as the spread of the Covid-19 continues. Offering a safe environment for our families to play recreational basketball is our top priority and it will require certain measures of safety. Some things will be subject to change, but at a minimum we will implement the following:

- If you are experiencing symptoms, please stay home and contact your coach.
- All persons will enter the gym through the door located on the right-hand side when facing the rear of the building. All persons will exit the gym through the door located on the left-hand side when facing the rear of the building.
- BMC has a mask optional policy at the moment. Masks are still strongly encouraged in many indoor environments. Those who plan on attending and sitting in the close proximity of the stands are advised to protect their personal health.
- Players and family members must exit the gym immediately following the conclusion of their respective game.
- The gym will be sanitized regularly and players will be asked to spread out on the bench.
- Sanitizer stations will be placed strategically in the gym.
- Players must bring their own drink to the game and it must be clearly marked so that they can identify that it is theirs. No sharing drinks among players/coaches.
- Players/coaches will not be permitted to shake hands at the conclusion of each game. We ask that each team show sportsmanship by acknowledging the other team in a socially distant manner.
- If a player becomes ill or begins to show signs of Covid-19 related symptoms during a game, they will be moved to an isolated area and supervised. A parent and/or caregiver will be contacted for pick-up.
