

LYSA Tee Ball Rules

Requirements:

Player must be 4 years old by May 1st of this year, and no older than 6 years old by May 1st of this year, in order to be eligible to play tee ball.

Tee ball games will not be umpired. LYSA expects their coaches to umpire their own games.

Rules:

Games will consist of 2 innings. An inning will consist of both teams batting their entire roster.

Every player on the team will be in the field for defense. Players playing the “pitcher” and “catcher” position on the field will wear helmets with facemasks.

If a ball is batted out of the infield, the play will be “live” until the ball is returned inside of the base path lines in the infield. The ball DOES NOT have to be controlled in the infield by a player, it simply has to be returned in the base paths. Once a ball is returned inside of the base path lines, all runners may proceed to the base they were running to when the ball crossed, and NO FURTHER.

There will be no advancement on over throws.

Players will have the option to have 3 pitches “soft tossed” to them by their coach instead of hitting off a tee. If the ball is not put into play after those 3 pitches, the ball is to then be batted from the tee.

Sliding of any kind is NOT allowed.

Unsportsman like conduct WILL NOT be tolerated from players, coaches, or spectators. LYSA retains the right to remove ANYONE who does not act in a sportsman like manner.
