

All players who meet the League Age requirement (in their All-Star division) who have played in 60% of their regularly scheduled regular season games are eligible to participate in their respective age division All Star Tournament.

A letter will be written to all families with an eligible player to see if they are willing and available to participate. The letter will include the commitment requirements, travel information, finances involved and more. A Player and Parent Commitment Letter will be attached; in order to be placed on the ballot it will be a requirement of each player to return this letter signed and dated by player and parent.

It will also include the following information:

Little League International rules require that players provide proof of age and residence. For proof of age, players who have been selected to an all-star team must provide an ORIGINAL birth certificate. It will be returned to you, but the ORIGINAL must be verified by District 2 staff. Other items that may be required are a completed School Enrollment Form, A Medical Release Form and A Media Release Form. You may also be asked to provide documents to establish residency such as a driver's license, fishing license, vehicle registration, utility bill, cable/internet bill, tax and/or insurance papers, etc...

Once eligibility and availability have been established, all names go on a ballot and the following voting process is applied.

## EXAMPLE: For a Team of 12

Players, Managers, Coaches (2 from each team) and SLL President vote for 7 Players and 1 Manager

Managers vote for the next 3 players

All Star Manager selects the final 2 players

All Star teams are announced at the field after the Championship game in each division.

\*This formula could vary depending on the number of players on the team. For example, The Board and/or the All-Star committee have the option to allow 13 players on an All-Star team.

\*\*Managers choose their coaches. Also, if two managers want to manager an All Star team, their names are added to the ballot with players and it's voted on according to the voting process above. However, if one manager is from an upper division and one manager is from a lower division, the coach in the upper division would be chosen and added to the ballot.



\*\*\*There are times (usually in the 8-10 Special Games and/or Softball) when there are less than 12 eligible and available players. When this happens, the VP of the division and/or Board members will make calls and/or email parents to try and roster a team. Selecting an All Star team with less than 12 players may require approval from District staff.
