# Team Parent's Roles

## Liaison

- Communicate messages from the Board to the Team and vice versa
  - Reiterate Email Announcements
  - Mail Box Slot in the Score Booth (pick up forms here)
    - Managers & Board Members have Keys
- Addressing Questions and Concerns from the Families of the Players
- \*\*\*Advocating/Caring for the kids on your team and their families\*\*\*
- Communication Apps: **GameChanger**, GroupMe, Band, Instagram, Text

# Team Parent's Roles

- **Logistics**

- Game Day Responsibilities:

- **Pre-Game:** Field Prep (both teams always when playing at Live Oak)
    - TCALL **Visiting** Team: Announcer, Pitch Count Machine, Scoreboard
    - TCALL **Home** Team: Official Scorekeeper, 50-50 Raffle Sales
      - **\*\*\* When hosting a team from an outside league (TCN, SEM), you are responsible for both Visiting and Home Team duties**
    - **Post-Game:** Clean-Up dugout/bleachers (both teams always when playing at Live Oak), Snacks
    - **Machine Pitch/Tball** – When on Diamond, you need to Field Prep, Announce, Clean, Snacks.
      - Loop Field Prep involves moving bleachers, you don't need to do scoreboard or pitch count, but you are still expected to do 50-50 raffle sales.
    - **50/50** items can be found in the announcing booth. Prices for tickets are marked on the buckets. Give customer the “keep this ticket” side and separate the other side of tickets in the bucket. Randomly pick a ticket at the end of the game. Give the winner 50% of the money collected during the game and give the other 50% to the league. Turn in money at booth.

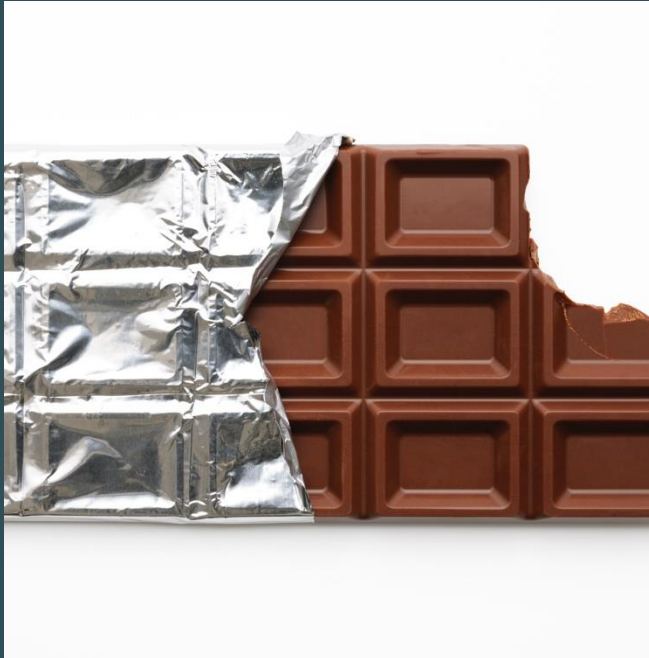

# Team Parent's Roles



- Logistics
  - **Fundraisers:**
    - Chocolate (minimum \$80 per box per player).
      - Fundraiser Money Due 2/21
      - Collect fundraiser \$ in one envelope and give to Treasurer
    - Discount Cards
      - Four cards (\$10 each) expected to be sold per player
      - These cards offer deals at local shops and restaurants
    - For turning in Fundraiser Money on time, Your Team will get \$25 towards their Team Party
  - **Snack Bar Duties**
    - Parents are expected to work two regular season shifts and one post-season shift (June-July)
    - Softball has the Snack Bar for the 1<sup>st</sup> half of the season and TCALL for the 2<sup>nd</sup> Half
  - Be Mindful of Who has "bought-out" their fundraiser (paid the league in advance) or forfeited snack bar \$

# Team Parent's Roles

- Fun Coordinator
  - **Optional: Walk-Up Music --- NEW THIS YEAR!**
    - Apps: Ballpark DJ
    - Completely optional. Each team will be responsible for their own lineup.
    - Each team must use their own speakers (Can't use scorebooth speakers).
    - Music cannot begin during active play and must conclude **BEFORE** the batter steps in the plate to avoid game delays.
    - All songs must be family friendly. No violence or profanity is allowed.
    - If the umpire or the coaching staff think music is too loud, inappropriate or delaying the game, music will not be permitted for the rest of the game.
    - Decibel Level Maximum 65
    - **\*\*\*Repeat violations will result in action to be taken by the board of directors regarding future use of music.\*\*\***
