



Policy Memorandum # 5: Club Pass (C-Pass)

Effective Date: January 1, 2026

1. Purpose

- 1.1 Establish guidelines for the use of the Club Pass (C-Pass) to allow Ogden Soccer Club (OSC) to move players between teams within the Club.
- 1.2 Support player development, maintain roster continuity, and reduce match cancellations while ensuring full compliance with UYSA Policy Section 6.

2. Rationale

- 2.1 Provide coaches with flexibility to support player development within OSC.
- 2.2 Reduce the need to cancel or reschedule matches due to injuries, absences, or conflicts.
- 2.3 Maintain roster stability without creating additional teams.
- 2.4 Prevent the use of C-Passes to influence promotion or relegation outcomes.

3. General Guidelines

- 3.1 A player may only C-Pass to another OSC team.
- 3.2 C-Pass use is limited to teams that share the same Club name, uniform brand/style, and development plan.
- 3.3 A player may use a maximum of four (4) C-Passes per season.
- 3.4 A player may only C-Pass down within their league structure and may not C-Pass to another team in the same division of their age group. Refer to UYSA Policy 6 (Player Development), Section 6324 for additional information.
- 3.5 Players may C-Pass up an unlimited number of divisions.
- 3.6 Regional restrictions apply for IRL teams (North, Metro, South).
- 3.7 Maximum number of C-Pass players per match:
 - 12U: three (3)
 - 13U–14U: four (4)
 - 15U–19U: five (5)
- 3.8 A player may only C-Pass in one match per day.
- 3.9 Teams using C-Pass players must roster at least nine (9) regularly rostered players (seven (7) for 12U).
- 3.10 C-Pass players count toward the maximum roster size.
- 3.11 Deactivation rules follow UYSA roster policies for each age group.
- 3.12 A player's primary team remains the team they are regularly rostered to unless an official transfer is completed.
- 3.13 A player may not C-Pass to a younger age group.
- 3.14 Players may not be involuntarily removed from their primary team except under UYSA Policy 7327.
- 3.15 A player remains eligible to play for their primary team at all times.

4. Restrictions Related to Multi-Rostering



- 4.1 Multi-rostered players may not use the C-Pass under any circumstances.
- 4.2 If a multi-rostered player uses a C-Pass, the match will be recorded as a forfeit.
- 4.3 For C-Pass purposes, High School Provisional (HSP) teams are considered Division 2.

5. High School Provisional (HSP) Considerations

- 5.1 A player who participates on a high school soccer team may not be rostered to an HSP team during the same seasonal year.
- 5.2 HSP teams may receive C-Pass players only from eligible OSC teams in accordance with UYSA Policy Section 6.
- 5.3 HSP participation does not affect a player's C-Pass eligibility for the regular competitive season unless the player is multi-rostered.
