



Policy Memorandum # 7: Multi-Roster Policy

Effective Date: January 1, 2026

1. Purpose & Definition

1.1 Establish clear guidelines for players who are registered to more than one UYSA team roster during the same seasonal or provisional period.

1.2 A player is considered multi-rostered when they appear on more than one roster within UYSA, including situations where a player participates on multiple High School Program (HSP) rosters during the same provisional season.

2. Eligibility Requirements

2.1 A player may be multi-rostered only under the following UYSA conditions:

- The two teams must be in different age groups or different gender divisions.
- The player must designate one roster as their Primary Team.
- All UYSA competition fees must be paid for both teams.

2.2 Team limits:

- U13 and older teams may not roster more than *eight (8)* multi-rostered players.
- U9–U10 players may not be registered simultaneously to more than one UYSA state competition team.

2.3 Recreation ↔ Competition multi-rostering:

- Requires approval from both coaches and the Ogden Soccer Club Recreational (GOAL) President.
- OSC Competitive (COMP) players may not multi-roster into recreation teams or recreational play.

3. Club Pass (C-Pass) Restrictions

3.1 Multi-rostered players may *not* use the Club Pass (C-Pass) for either their primary or secondary team.

3.2 If a multi-rostered player uses a C-Pass, the match(es) will be recorded as forfeits.

3.3 Exception for HSP Season

3.3.1 Multi-rostering during the High School Program (HSP) provisional season does **not** affect C-Pass eligibility for the regular competitive season.

3.3.2 Players remain fully eligible to C-Pass with their OSC COMP team during the regular season (spring for girls, fall for boys).

3.3.3 Multi-roster status applies only to the HSP season and does not extend into the competitive season.

4. Approval Requirements

4.1 Multi-rostering is a privilege, not a right. All arrangements must be approved by:

- The player's Primary Team Coach
- The Secondary Team Coach (if applicable)
- Ogden Soccer Club Certified League Registrar (CLR)
- The CLR for the secondary team



4.2 The player must be fully registered with their *Primary Team* before submitting a multi-roster request.

5. Required Documentation

5.1 The following must be completed for approval:

5.1.1 *Multi-Roster Action Form*, fully completed with all required signatures

5.1.2 Payment of applicable UYSA fees:

- Recreation → Competition Fee: \$3.00
- Competition League Fee (U11–U19): \$33.00 per team

5.1.3 Upload of all required documents in SOMS (Sports Connect)

5.1.4 Verification by the Certified League Registrar

5.2 Once all requirements are met, the CLR will manually add the player to the secondary roster.

6. Player Obligations

6.1 A multi-rostered player's first obligation is to their Primary Team.

6.2 To change their Primary Team, the player must follow the UYSA transfer procedure.

6.3 To discontinue multi-rostering, the player must complete a Player Permission to Drop Form before being released.
