



Parent Registration Guide

We're excited to have your player join our community. This guide outlines what families need to know about registering for the upcoming season, including requirements, deadlines, and how to complete the process.

1. Who Must Register?

All players, coaches, and team volunteers must register each year through Utah Youth Soccer Association's online system (SOMS / Affinity Sports). This can all be completed via the Ogden Soccer Club website, www.ogdensoccer.com.

2. Player Registration Requirements

Every player must:

- Register online through OSC's registration link
- Be registered under a parent/guardian account
- Upload a current headshot photo
 - No hats, sunglasses, filters, or funny faces
 - Taken within the last year
- Provide proof of age (birth certificate, passport, driver's license, etc.)
- Pay all required Ogden Soccer Club and UYSA fees
- Sign all electronic waivers and agreements

Players Turning 18

- Players who turn 18 must complete SafeSport Abuse Prevention Training to remain eligible.
 - Update the UYSA profile with the same email used for SafeSport

3. How to Register Your Player

1. Go to www.OgdenSoccer.com → *Registration*
2. Log in or create a family account
3. Add/select your player
4. Click *Register as Player*
5. Choose the play level or enter an assignment code (if provided)
6. Complete all forms and waivers
7. Submit payment



8. Print your receipt for your team manager (optional)

4. Play Types at Ogden Soccer Club

OSC may use UYSA play levels or club-specific names such as:

- *Little Lions* – Introductory
- *GOAL* – Recreation
- *COMP* – Select
- *X-League*—U9/10 Age Level Comp
- *Premier* – Advanced Competitive

Fees may vary by play type and team. Coaches may levy additional fees for tournaments and out-of-season gaming

5. What Coaches Must Complete

All coaches and team administrators must:

- Register in SOMS
- Complete a background check (every 2 years)
- Upload a headshot photo
- Complete *SafeSport* and *HEADS UP Concussion Training*
- Sign the Code of Conduct and Volunteer Disclosure
- Hold a *Grassroots Coaching License* (minimum) or seasonal waiver

Coaches cannot participate until fully cleared and rostered.

6. Insurance Coverage

All registered players, coaches, and volunteers receive UYSA-provided:

- General Liability Insurance
- Secondary Accident Insurance for injuries during sanctioned activities

7. Competition & Gaming League Teams

All Ogden Soccer Club teams play in the UYSA Gaming Leagues must. This partnership ensures OSC maintains a:

- *Certified League Registrar* who works with UYSA to ensure proper registration of players and teams within the competition league
- Meet UYSA deadlines:
 - *Fall*: July 1
 - *Spring*: February 1
- Ensure all players and coaches have completed required documentation
