



T-Ball FAQ

What is T-Ball at NJBSL?

- T-Ball is a non-competitive introduction to baseball and softball. We focus on the fundamentals of the game while keeping it a fun environment for the players.

What is the minimum age to sign my child up for T-Ball with NJBSL?

- You can sign your child up for T-Ball if they turn 5 on or before August 1st of the current year.

Do we have to live in Northwest school district to participate in T-Ball?

- No, there is not a requirement to live within Northwest school district.

Where are the games played?

- All T-Ball games are played at the NJBSL Complex which is located at 8845 Erie Ave N, Canal Fulton, Ohio 44614.

How long is the T-Ball season?

- Our season officially begins April 1st, however practices and games are based on the weather and field conditions this early in the season. Our season can go until the last week in June. It can end sooner depending on the weather.

What does the practice and game schedule look like?

- Practices begin in the month of April and are scheduled for 2 days a week based on your coach's schedule. Once games start in May, the coaches are advised to go to a 1 practice and 1 game schedule. The games are played on Saturday unless it's a holiday weekend. All rescheduled and/or make-up games will be played on Wednesday.

How long is a game?

- In T-Ball at NJBSL, we have a 4 inning or 60-minute game. Whichever comes first.

What is included in my registration cost?

- NJBSL will provide a hat and jersey to your athlete.

What equipment is required to be provided by the parent?

- We ask the players to provide their own glove, cleats, bat, and helmet. There will be a couple team helmets available for use at the parents' discretion.
