



Lake Murray Little League Manager/Coach Code of Conduct

A manager/coach will understand the amount of influence he/she has, and use it to educate the players to the best of their ability. Remember, teams will mirror their coaching.

A manager/coach will be respectful of all players, coaches and officials. Make certain your praise is equal in tone and volume to your criticism.

A manager/coach will understand the rules of the game, teach the rules to his/her players and ensure the rules are constantly applied. Little League Baseball is different from college or the MLB. Do not assume they are the same.

A manager/coach will make sure all spectators and fellow coaches are respectful, or will kindly have them leave the area of play. This will be established early with your parents and families, BEFORE games start.

A manager/coach will make sure any person who is in contact with the players during practice or a game has completed a Little League International background check.

A manager/coach will maintain our home playing surfaces and make sure his/her team respects fields they are visiting. It is important we provide and care for safe playing environments.

A manager/coach will understand the LMLL bylaws, particularly in how they pertain to special rules for each division.

A manager/coach will teach and exemplify the ideals of sportsmanship and integrity. Good character is the foundation of our league.

A manager/coach will understand he/she represents LMLL, their team and themselves as a whole. You will carry this with you throughout the community.

By reading and signing this document, you understand you will be held to these standards. Failure to live up to these standards will result in progressive discipline at the LMLL Board's discretion.
