In this regard, please note that parents, players and any volunteer may be subject to discipline, including suspension or permanent termination of membership, when, in the sole reasonable opinion of the NPMYAC Board of Directors, the conduct of a parent, player or volunteer is determined to be detrimental to the best interests of NPMYAC or Little League Baseball.

Effective immediately, all managers, coaches, team parents, parents and players are placed on notice that you run the risk of immediate suspension or permanent termination of your membership if you are responsible, directly or indirectly (implied), for making disparaging, threatening, offensive, retaliatory or otherwise inappropriate comments made about the league, any board member, any parent or any player on Facebook, Twitter or any other social networking site.
