BONSALL FALLBROOK LITTLE LEAGUE COVID-19 SAFETY PROTOCOL AGREEMENT

On behalf of my child for whom I serve as legal guardian, I understand that Bonsall Fallbrook Little League (BFL) requires adherence to the following safety protocols that were developed February 1st, 2021 utilizing guidelines provided by the County of San Diego, California Department of Public Health, Little League International, and the CDC in response to the current spread of COVID-19.

1. All use of BFL fields and facilities is scheduled and at the discretion of BFL President and Coaching Coordinator. Teams may only use fields during scheduled times and may not hold other team activities at or outside our facilities unless approved in advance.
2. Practices are limited to rostered players, managers, and coaches on fields. Other family members present during practice must remain in stands or adjacent green spaces at a safe distance from others at all times.
3. Teams must remain on their designated field and avoid interaction with other teams present during their practice times.
4. No games will be held until San Diego County moves into the Red COVID Safety Tier per State and County guidelines.
5. Carpools with members living outside the same household are discouraged.
6. All players, coaches, and board members will have their temperature checked prior to entering facilities. Any person with a temperature above 99.9°F will be required to leave immediately.
7. All players will be required to use hand sanitizer prior to starting practice and at multiple times during practice. Hand Sanitizer will be provided by BFL and will be from the approved list prepared by the FDA for protection from COVID-19.
8. All players and coaches are instructed to stay home if they, or any member of their household, have any symptoms of illness, including, but not limited to, fever, cough, sore throat, sneezing, body aches, loss of sense of smell or taste, difficulty breathing, or fatigue. Any player or coach who tests positive, or has a household member who tests positive, for COVID-19 cannot return for at least 14 days since the test was conducted, and must bring a physician’s note indicating they are no longer contagious to others.
9. Players are encouraged to provide their own gear for use. Players may use league provided gear, which will be sanitized by a coach or board member after each use.
10. Players are permitted, but not required, to wear face masks during practice. We encourage players wear a mask when entering and exiting BFL facilities.
11. Managers and coaches must adhere to any applicable local regulations regarding mask use. Managers and Coaches must wear a mask when within 6 feet of any other person.
12. No food shall be brought to practices. Players must bring their own water bottles.
13. Players will be kept at least 6 feet apart as much as possible. At times players may need to be in closer proximity when simulating game play. Any concerns should immediately be brought up to team manager or board member on duty.
14. Dug out use to be restricted until San Diego County moves into the Red COVID Safety Tier per State and County guidelines.
15. Players are not permitted to gather, and batting cages will be limited to one player while another player waits more than 6 feet away from batting cage entrance. Bullpens will be limited to two players.
16. Activities or gatherings of any kind before or after practice are prohibited. Players shall arrive no earlier than 10 minutes before scheduled start times and must be picked up promptly upon completion of practice. Players are to be picked up and dropped off at the large gate near the Boys & Girls Club. Parents are encouraged to remain in vehicles during drop off and pick up. Coaches and managers may arrive up to 30 minutes prior to scheduled practice start times to prepare fields.

I acknowledge that I have read and understand the protocols outlined above and agree that I and my child will strictly comply with them at all times. I understand that any failure to comply will result in a loss of ability to participate in BFL activities, suspension from the league, and forfeiture of any registration fees paid.
