

## **Concession Stand**

We need 4 people per shift, each shift is 2 ½ - 3 hours. Weeknight games are a single shift and Saturday will have 2 - 3 shifts. There will always be at least one board member working with our volunteers. Volunteers should plan to arrive at least 30 minutes before game time to ensure everything is ready to go when the game begins, and should plan to stay about 15-30 minutes after the end of the game to clean up and close up. We welcome high schoolers who need volunteer hours to come help out anytime and we will sign off on their volunteer forms.

- ★ You will never be asked to work the concession stand during one of your child's games
- ★ There are several different positions within the concession stand, so everyone can find a place they feel comfortable:

Register - iPad with the Square app. All items are preloaded so you only have to find and tap the item being purchased and it will add to the cart. The iPad will do the math for you to make change for cash payments. We accept cash, card, Apple Pay, Google Wallet etc.

Deep Fryer - Dual basket so two items can be made at the same time. Serving size and fry times for each item are posted on the fryer. Items are cooked, drained, seasoned, put in paper boats and set under the warmer.

Grill - Hamburger patties, hot dogs and occasionally fresh ribeye - season, grill, put on buns and wrap up. Mark with a permanent marker: H for hamburger, C for cheeseburger, R for ribeye.

Other - These roles are often shared between people or one person doing several of them since they take less time than the grill, fryer and register.

- ★ Popcorn machine - turn on, empty kernels/butter into the kettle, pop, dump and scoop into serving bags and set on the counter
- ★ Filling Nacho trays
- ★ Fountain Drinks - filling as ordered
- ★ Handing out Player Snacks after games
- ★ Handing out hot food items as customers request them
- ★ Keeping things stocked - snack items, candy, condiments, drink fridge

Opening and Closing the Bathrooms - This is part of the concession stand shift. The bathrooms will need to be unlocked, checked for cleanliness, toilet paper, paper towels and soap. At the end of the final shift, check toilet paper, paper towels and soap again and refill as needed, take out the trash, spray and wipe surfaces and lock up.
