LOS NIÑOS LITTLE LEAGUE RULES & CODE OF CONDUCT

LNLL fields are yours. Please take care of your fields and adhere to the following rules and expected conduct. *Please*note: Many of the rules are determined by legal guidelines and insurance coverage.

- Attempt to win through skill, effort, practice and tactics; but always play fairly.
- Avoid inappropriate behavior, including the use of profanity or other inappropriate language, during practices, games and other baseball activities.
- Baseball gear should be left at the benches. Do not take your bags into cages or in halls/walkways.
- Batting helmets usage is always required in the batting cage during all hitting drills. No exception.
- Please arrive 10-15 min earlier for practices.
- Full catchers gear (helmet, mask, glove and cup at a minimum) is required during all live pitching drills or live batting practices.
- Go directly to the coach with any questions or concerns and follow directions from your coach.
- Inform coach as soon as possible (at least 24 hrs.) if missing a game or practice.
- Never argue with or criticize coaches, teammates, opponents or umpires.
- Rubber cleats are mandatory for coach pitch, Minors and Majors league, Except for Tee-ball, for Junior's metal or rubber are recommended.
- No throwing balls or swinging bats inside dugout. If you are not hitting or waiting your turn, hold your bat by the barrel by your side.
- Only water and sports drinks are allowed, NO food allowed in dugout
- Parents, siblings & friends are not allowed in dugout or field during practice/lessons. Please watch/wait at benches.
- Only Registered Managers, coaches and players must remain inside the dugout area during the game
- Pets are not allowed on the field or dugout
- Managers/ Coaches cannot sit on bucket outside the dugout
- Play hard on every play and in every practice and game.
- Please dispose of all trash from Dugout and benches after any practice or game.
- Please make sure all your gear is labeled.
- Remember that the game is for the players, not for the parents. As such, parents are required to always
 remain outside of the dugout and off the field and will refrain from speaking to players until the game is over.
 Cheer for your player, but <u>do not coach from the stands</u>.
- Respect the field. No seeds/tobacco/ E-cigarettes near dugout or benches.
- Run full speed on the base paths. Always pick up your base coach after every pitch. Never miss any sign.
- Run on/off the field every inning of every game and practice.
- Take victory modestly, defeat graciously and always exhibit good sportsmanship.
- To use Batting cages, you must call or Text LNLL facility manager for reservation prior to arrival.
- Treat coaches, parents, teammates and opponents with respect. Be supportive and encouraging.
- For Game and Practice Wear the appropriate uniform/equipment with jersey always tucked in and wear hat forward.
