

Dear WALL Members,

This note is meant to be a follow up from our previous update released on May 4, 2020. Please make sure you review that note prior to reading this so you are informed on items mentioned here. That update can be found on the WALL Facebook page, WALL internet page and in an email sent to the whole league. We wanted to send out a quick update to build on the notes already released. The WALL Board and Little League International continue to monitor local, state and federal guidelines in order to be up to date on the latest developments of the COVID situation

These developments continue to change on seemingly a daily basis. On Friday May 8, 2020 the state of Pennsylvania extended the stay at home order for counties that encompass WALL. The new date for the stay at home order is now June 4, 2020. When we are under a stay at home order we are still under the red phase of reopening. Once the stay at home order is lifted we begin to move into the yellow phase. As a league, we are not able to begin any baseball/softball related activities until we are moved to green phase. According to the state reopening plan we would not be able to begin Little League activities until August 13, 2020 given this extended stay at home order. There is a possibility that these dates are adjusted again (sooner or later), but this is now where we are.

We are still taking refund requests. The deadline to request a refund has now been extended to June 14, 2020. This new date reflects the shifting of a potential start date and still gives the league enough time to secure items needed to operate the season. Assuming we do begin the LL season in August, it is unclear what that would entail. Perhaps a shorter season; perhaps a “fall ball” scenario. In any event, please be assured that the WALL Board is working together to provide baseball and softball to our children.

Keep in mind that you can request to have your fees roll over to next year as a credit or receive your fees back via check or PayPal. And, of course, if, due to government regulations, we find ourselves unable to have a 2020 WALL season, all families will receive a refund with those same options. If you request a refund and take the credit option then you will see this credit in your account when you sign up next year for the 2021 WALL season.
