



Covid-19 Guidelines:

Due to concerns surrounding the novel Coronavirus (COVID-19), Trenholm Little League has adopted the below measures with guidance from the Center for Disease Control and Prevention, the World Health Organization and Local health authorities. These measures were adopted by TLL in the Summer of 2020 and will remain in effect for the foreseeable future and we cannot stress enough how vital it is that all TLL participants adhere to these guidelines. We all need to do our part to help monitor the health of each participant and spectator.

- 1: All parents are encouraged take the temperature of their player and everyone coming to the park prior to leaving for the fields.
- 2: Anyone with a fever, cough, or any other COVID 19 symptoms or recent exposure to those symptoms should stay home and will not be allowed at Trenholm Park.
- 3: Wearing masks is optional for players.
- 4: Coaches/Fans are required to wear masks and practice social distancing. (Any non-player age 10 or above are required to wear mask)
- 5: Instituting a No-Contact/No-Handshake' Policy.
- 6: Hand Sanitizer/sanitizing sprays will be present in all dugouts at all times for players and equipment (Game balls should be sanitized between each half inning, dugouts should be sanitized between games/teams and any shared equipment should be sanitized if applicable)
- 7: Recommend not sharing equipment (bats will be sanitized between batters)
- 8: Players will sit in designated marked areas of bleachers instead of dugout when not on field. No more than 3 players in dugout at one time (Pitcher/Catcher/On Deck Hitter). The catcher position will be eliminated in all Coach Pitch Divisions.
- 9: Spectators are encouraged to bring their own chairs and practice social distancing. Bleachers are not available for fan use.
- 10: Players may not have sunflower seeds/gum

11: All players/fans participate at their own risk

12: No Team Snacks! Parents can provide snacks to their player ONLY.

13. In event that a player/coach test positive for COVID-19 the infected person is required to report immediately to the TLL President, Jeff Coleman at Trenholmllpresident@gmail.com.

TLL positive COVID-19 policy

If a player/coach/league staff tests positive for COVID-19 the following procedures will be implemented.

- *The team of infected individual is notified that an individual associated with team tested positive (all names of infected individuals will remain anonymous).*
- *The Family of infected individual will be required to quarantine for 10 days.*
- *The infected individual must have a negative test result before returning to TLL activities.*

14. All participating players are required to sign the TLL COVID-19 Release Form and return to league prior to any team activities.
