General Information and FLLAA Park Rules

Games will be played in accordance with official Little League Tournament Rules.

- Teams should arrive at least one hour prior to their scheduled game time.
- Team affidavits, supporting documents, and Medical Release Forms will be reviewed prior to tournament play.
- The concession stand will be open throughout the tournament with food and beverage options available.
- Tobacco, vaping products, alcohol, and electronic smoking devices are strictly prohibited inside the park. Smoking is only permitted in designated parking lot areas at least 50 feet from entrances and exits.
- Freeport Little League maintains a ZERO TOLERANCE policy regarding unsportsmanlike conduct, harassment, obscene language, or negative behavior toward players, coaches, umpires, or spectators. Violators may be removed from the facility immediately.
- Coaches are responsible for communicating tournament expectations and sportsmanship standards to players and spectators before games begin.
- Umpires will inspect all equipment prior to games. Unsafe or non-compliant equipment will not be permitted for use.
- Batting cages located between Fields 3 and 4 are available on a first-come, first-served basis. Please be courteous and allow equal access for all teams.
- Home and visiting teams will be determined by coin toss unless otherwise directed by tournament officials.
- The National Anthem and Little League Pledge will be conducted prior to the first game each day.
- Ice water, cups, and trash bags will be provided in dugouts. Teams are responsible for cleaning dugouts and spectator areas after games.
- In accordance with Little League rules, flash photography and cell phone use are prohibited on the field and inside dugouts by players, coaches, and managers.

Player Safety & Heat Precautions

Florida summer conditions can be extremely hot and humid. Please help monitor players closely for dehydration and heat-related illness.

- Encourage players to hydrate frequently before, during, and after games.
- Water coolers will be available in each dugout.
- If a player appears distressed or overheated, notify the umpire immediately and move the player into shade or a cooled area.
- In the event of a medical emergency or suspected heat exhaustion, emergency services will be contacted immediately.
- During inclement weather or lightning delays, all participants and spectators should follow tournament staff instructions and return to vehicles if directed.
