Tournament Information & Park Rules

1. The following items will be reviewed during the Managers/Coaches Meeting or prior to each team's first game:
 - Team Affidavits and supporting documentation
 - Medical Release Forms
2. The concession stand will be open throughout the tournament and will offer a variety of food and beverage options.
3. The use of tobacco products, vaping devices, and alcohol is strictly prohibited inside the park. Smoking is permitted only in designated parking lot areas located at least 50 feet from all entrances and exits.
4. ALL County posted park rules must be followed at all times
5. Unsportsmanlike conduct, obscene language, or harassment of any kind will not be tolerated. Individuals engaging in inappropriate behavior may be removed from the park immediately.

Little League Baseball and Softball maintain a zero-tolerance policy regarding negative comments or behavior directed toward umpires, players, coaches, volunteers, or spectators. Managers and coaches are responsible for informing players and spectators of these expectations prior to game time and are expected to assist in maintaining a positive environment throughout the tournament.

6. All games will be conducted in accordance with official tournament rules and regulations.
7. Umpires will inspect all equipment prior to each game. Any equipment deemed unsafe or non-compliant will be removed from play. Teams should place all equipment outside the dugout before games for inspection.
8. Teams should arrive at the park no later than one hour prior to their scheduled game time.
9. A pregame coin toss will determine the home and visiting teams.
10. Pregame infield practice schedule:
 - Visiting Team: 30 minutes prior to game time for 10 minutes

- Home Team: Immediately following the visiting team for 10 minutes
11. The National Anthem, the Little League Pledge, and the Volunteer/Parent Pledge will be conducted prior to the first game each day.
 12. Pitching Affidavits must be completed following each game. Team managers are responsible for ensuring all information is accurate and submitted promptly.
 13. In accordance with Little League Baseball and Softball rules, flash photography and cell phone use are prohibited on the field and inside dugouts by players, managers, and coaches.

Player Safety & Heat Awareness

To help prevent heat-related illness and dehydration, teams are encouraged to closely monitor players throughout the tournament and ensure they remain properly hydrated.

1. Players should drink water frequently before, during, and after games. Water coolers will be provided in each dugout for players and coaches.
2. If a player appears distressed or overheated while on the field, notify the umpire immediately, substitute the player, and move them to a shaded or cooler area as quickly as possible.
3. In the event of suspected heat exhaustion or a medical emergency, 911 will be contacted immediately. Until medical personnel arrive, provide water and apply ice bags, available from the concession stand, to assist with cooling.
4. During inclement weather or thunderstorms, all participants and spectators should be prepared to return to their vehicles as directed by tournament staff. Players may not leave the premises without approval from their manager and the Tournament Coordinator.
