# **General information and BAYA park rules:**

1. The following will be reviewed at the above meeting or before your first game.
  - a. Team Affidavits and supporting paperwork (if applicable)
  - b. Medical Release Forms
2. Our concessions stand will be open throughout the duration of the tournament. We ask you please do not bring coolers into the park (exception, 1 cooler is allowed in each dugout for players).
3. The use of tobacco or alcohol is prohibited inside our park; this also includes electronic (vape) devices. Smoking is allowed in the parking lot, but you must be 50 feet away from all activities.
4. Obscene language or harassment by anyone will not be tolerated. Offenders will be ejected from the park. We have a **ZERO TOLERANCE RULE**. We will not tolerate any negative comments toward Umpires, Players, other fans, or Coaches. **Coaches, please inform your parents, fans, and players that this is considered their warning**. If a problem arises, that person can expect to be asked to leave the park. We expect the Coach to control their players and fans by informing them of these rules ahead of game time.
5. Games will be played in accordance with Tournament rules and regulations
6. Teams should arrive at least one hour prior to scheduled game time to allow for proper warm-up and stretching time.
7. Warm-up fields are available in the park. You can use fields around the main concessions building.

8. A coin toss will be accomplished prior to the game to determine home team. Home team should occupy the **Third base** dugout.
9. The visiting team will have the option to take infield 30 minutes prior to the start of the game. The home team will have the infield, 10 minutes prior to game start to accomplish the same.
10. The National Anthem and reciting of the Little League and volunteer pledge will take place prior to the first game of the day.
11. Pitching affidavits (If applicable) will be filled out completely following each game. The managers are responsible for ensuring the affidavits are correct.
12. Ice water, cups, and trash bins will be provided in the dugouts. Teams are responsible for ensuring dugouts are clean before exiting after each game.
13. No flash photography or cell phones will be allowed on the fields or in the dugouts per Little League rules.
14. Drone usage is prohibited within the park. Drone usage is a safety concern for players, coaches, and fans.

## **Safety Tips**

To help prevent heat related player problems, precautions must be taken to make sure players on your team **DO NOT** hyperventilate or dehydrate. Have players drink plenty of water on game days.

1. Suggest players take drinks of water before going out on the field and when returning from the field. (Water coolers will be provided in dugout for the players & coaches)

2. If a player looks distressed while standing in the hot sun, notify the umpire then substitute that player and get them into the shade or dugout ASAP.

3. If a player collapses because of heat exhaustion, 911 will be called immediately. Get the player to drink water and use the ice bags available in the concession stand to cool him/her down until Medical Personnel arrive.

4. During inclement weather and thunderstorms, please be prepared to evacuate to your vehicles as directed and **DO NOT** Leave with a player until their manager has approval from the Tournament Coordinator.

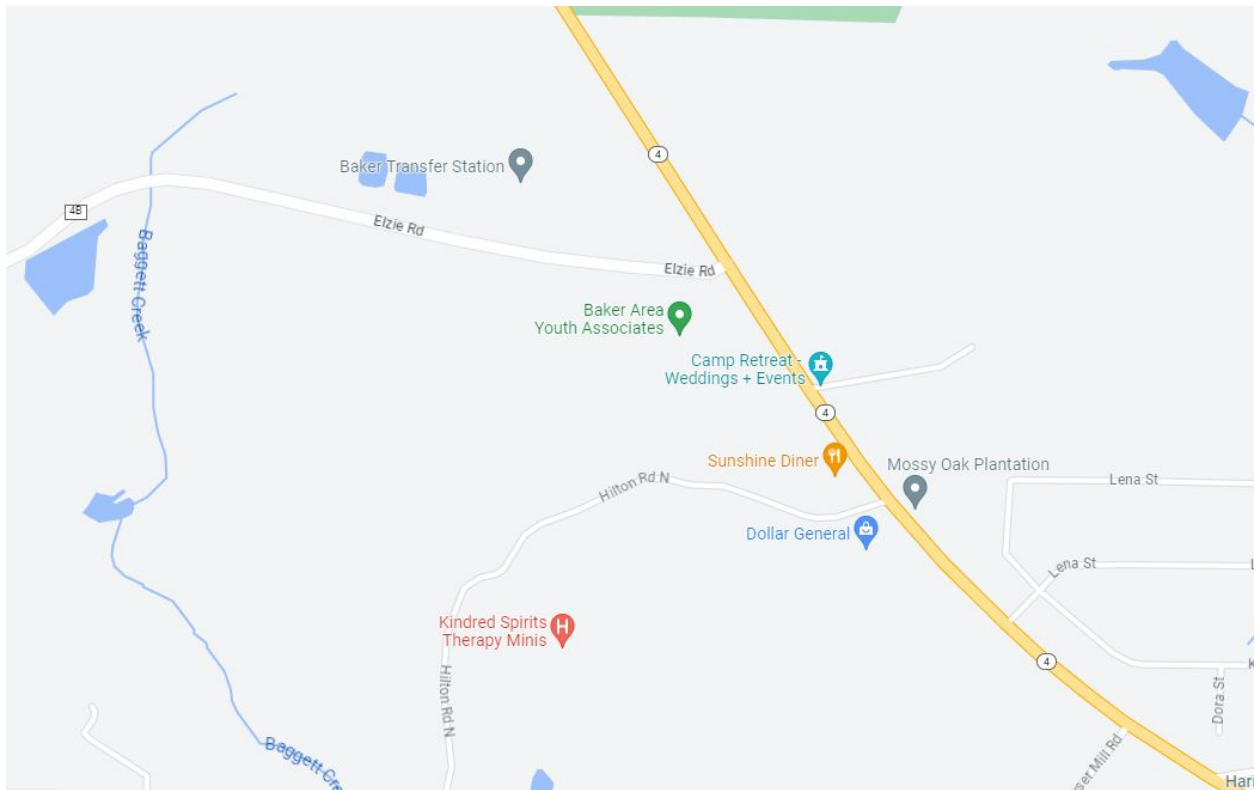

Turn right onto Highway 4 (SR-4). Go for 2.5 mi.

Turn left onto Charlie Day Rd (CR-4B). Go for 0.1 mi. Ballfields will be on your left.

### **From Holt:**

From I-10, Head towards Main St/ HWY 90 (US-90) Go for 2.6 mi. Turn left onto Galliver Cut Off (CR-189). Go for 3.4 mi.

Turn right onto Charlie Day Rd (CR-4B). Go for 1.0 mi. Ballfields will be on your right.
