

# Little League Softball All-Stars - Letter of Intent



This letter **MUST** be emailed to [sballstars@tritownll.org](mailto:sballstars@tritownll.org) by May 10th (print, sign, send photo or scan). If we don't have this form, we cannot consider your player for Little League All-Star Tournament play.

All players league age 8 through 12 are eligible for All-Star play however the league will determine which age groups it will enter into the tournament. There is a potential 3TLL will combine with a local league to form a team. Age is determined via the Little League Age found on the 3TLL & LittleLeague.org websites.

My child \_\_\_\_\_ will be available to participate in Little League All-Star tournament play. I understand that by indicating that my player is available for the following:

## Commitment

- I am committing to my player being available for tournament practice (and games) **nearly daily** starting the second Saturday of June through the second Saturday of July. Practice and game days vary but plan on events 5 or more days of the week.
- I also understand that the commitment to the team continues until they have suffered two losses in a tournament round. This date could be as late as August 31 (highly unlikely), but is at least somewhat likely through the second week of July.
- That forfeiting Little League All-Star teams due to lack of attendance by chosen players could cost our league its charter.

## Documentation

If your child has been enrolled as a student of RSU 5 prior to October 1 the school district can provide school enrollment information on your behalf to prove residency and eligibility for All-Stars. Please review and check the statement below if your child is an RSU 5 student.

If your child is **NOT** an RSU 5 student, you must provide additional documentation to prove residency. You will only need to provide these documents *if* your child is selected to an All-Star team. The selections will be made by May 25th, and the documents **must be presented to your team coach by May 30th**. One document from each group below is required:
