All players league age 8 through 12 are eligible for All-Star play however the league will determine which age groups it will enter into the tournament. There is a potential 3TLL will combine with a local league to form a team. Age is determined via the Little League Age found on the 3TLL & LittleLeague.org websites.

Commitment			
<ul> <li>I am committing to my player being available for tournament practice (and games) <u>nearly daily</u> starting the second Saturday of June through the second Saturday of July. Practice and game days vary but plan on events 5 or more days of the week.</li> <li>I also understand that the commitment to the team continues until they have suffered two losses in a tournament round. This date could be as late as August 31 (highly unlikely), but is at least somewhat likely through the second week of July.</li> <li>That forfeiting Little League All-Star teams due to lack of attendance by chosen players could cost our league its charter.</li> </ul>
