7. 2018 Age Affected Players
  - a. Reminded leagues of the players that loose a LL age year: those with birthdays between for May 1<sup>st</sup> & -Aug 31<sup>st</sup> of 2001/2002/2003 & 2004 (see attached)
8. Discuss District Jr/Sr age divisions –
  - a. players league age 13,14,15 & 16 are eligible for regular season Seniors divisions. 13 & 14 year olds that play in EITHER JR or SR division regular season are eligible for post season tournament at Juniors level.
  - b. The following leagues are considering Seniors Divisions  
Newville\Ship\York City \Pen Mar\Greencastle\Gettysburg\

9. PCA 2018 is in final year of 3 year agreement
  - a. Dates & locations for 2018 -
    - i. DCG1 –East Sun March 4<sup>th</sup> 1-3 pm LOCATION - Northeastern
    - ii. DGC1 – West Sun March 11<sup>th</sup> 1-3pm LOCATION Gettysburg School
    - iii. DGC2 – Central Sun March 25<sup>th</sup> 1-3 pm LOCATON Newville
  - b. Discussed District coach training options for 2019 and beyond. Consider offering one PCA, one DOYLE mechanics clinic for new or young coaches, one advanced clinic for experienced coaches each season and rotate each year location of each between East, Central & West to keep each fresh for coaches. It was believed we could offer this for similar or slightly higher annual assessment as the current PCA (approx. \$200 - \$250)
    - iv. Leagues were asked to take this concept back to their boards and coaches for feedback
    - v. Leagues were asked to look into advanced training clinic offerings.
10. Fall ball – There is renewed interest in a D14 Fall Program. Dave Hoover (Carlisle) offered to take the lead on coordinating this effort. A meeting was scheduled for Feb 11<sup>th</sup> from 4-6 at Eddies to begin planning. The following 13 Leagues expressed interest. Carlisle/South Middleton/Bermudian/York City/Northeastern/Dover/York LL/ SYC/Newville/Spring Grove/Gettysburg/Dillsburg – Dallastown is anticipated to be interested.
11. Additional Baseball Offerings, and possible collaboration w/ D6:
  - a. 50/70 – D6 participation in D14 Interlock – all in agreement
  - b. There was discussion on ways to offer additional ball to the tourn teams that get eliminated in pool play on a voluntary basis – and expand LL baseball into summer via special games.
    - vi. Int'l Pool Play 2<sup>nd</sup> Chance tourn or RR weekend games internally or w/ D6:
    - vii. South Middleton is planning on piloting – as a fundraiser charging for ex. \$200/team
    - viii. Umpire availability is a potential concern
      - i. Additionally, similar considerations for CBT Teams. CBT D14/D6 champ playoffs &/or 2<sup>nd</sup> Chance tourn play/RR weekend games
  - c. Jamie Snyder (Northeastern) polled the group on interest for Tournament of Champions suggesting week of June 11<sup>th</sup> – 15<sup>th</sup>. There was sufficient interest and Jamie will coordinate.
12. Reminders:
  - a. Charter application submittal through the Data Center – LL Insurance coverage ends Dec 31 2018 premiums must be paid prior to Jan 1, 2018 to maintain continuous coverage
  - b. Update BOD on Data Center
  - c. Background Checks – Leagues encouraged to get their BOD checks done and not wait -
  - d. ASAP Plans – goal 100% - DEADLINE MARCH 1<sup>st</sup> for District Incentives (send an editable copy to DA for future reference should your Safety Officer leave w/ the files)
  - e. Leagues were reminded to review their Constitutions

***Open Discussion- Votes:***

**York City motioned / Northeastern 2<sup>nd</sup>** : that all leagues not submitting their ASAP plan by the deadline required to meet the LL District ASAP Incentive (\$300 credit to district Account) be required to split the cost of the lost revenue and be invoiced by the district.

**MOTION CARRIED**

The following insurance questions were raised:

- Must a location be listed as an additional insured for LL coverage to be in effect for eligible persons under the LL policy? Pete will follow up w/ LL Int'l and find out.
- Are players, coaches & managers covered during assessments/tryouts etc before the registration data is uploaded. Per "preseason tryout period" provision a) under Classes of eligible persons page 1 of LL Insurance Description of Coverage (found in your Resource Manual) it appears that they are. Again, Pete will confirm w/ LL Int'l.

### District 14 Umpire Clinics

The District 14 Umpire Clinics are four (4) sessions in length. An umpire has to attend all four (4) sessions in order to get credit for the clinic. There will be different material presented at each session.

Managers, coaches and league officials are encouraged to attend Sessions one (1) and two (2). The curriculum is structured so that all of the rules discussions are presented in the first two sessions. The managers, coaches and league officials will be able to hear the same interpretations and explanations that are given to the umpires. This helps to eliminate myths and misconceptions.

The clinic sessions are “mirrored” to provide the student the flexibility to attend a missed session. In other words; the same material is presented at Session 1 in Gettysburg on February 25<sup>th</sup> that is presented at Session 1 in Spring Grove on February 27<sup>th</sup> and at Session 1 in Newville on February 28<sup>th</sup>. The interactive discussions with the attendees may vary, but the material that is presented is always the same.

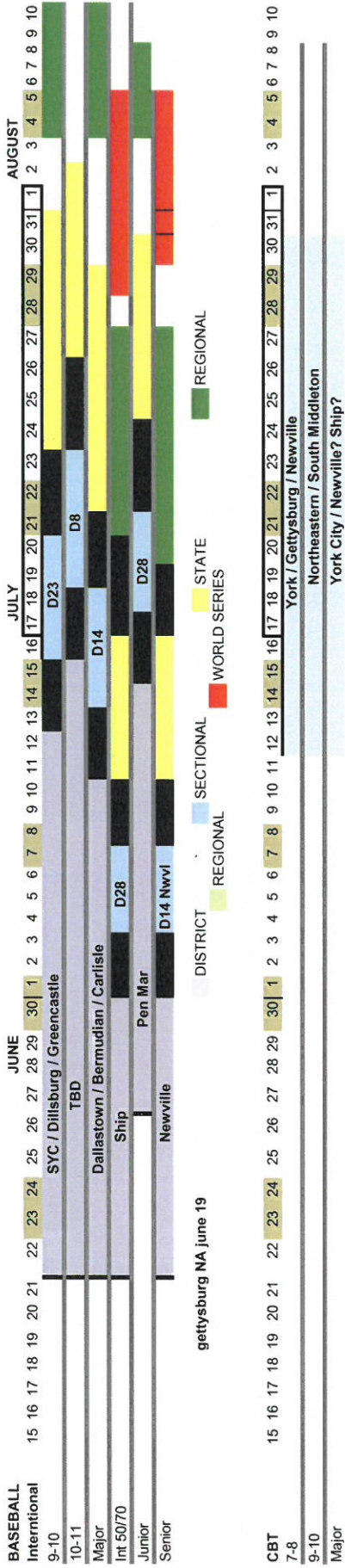
