


Introduction to our Hitting Instructor - Trevor Caldwell

I was born and raised in Aurora, CO and attended Rangeview high school where I played three years under Coach Mike Hamilton, and one year under Coach Brian Gausman. My senior year I led the offense as well as the EMAC with a .522 batting average, as well as leading the team in doubles (13) and RBI's (32)

I spent my first two years of college at Kansas City Kansas Community College where I started and played all games in left field. I finished my first year hitting .367 and my last year hitting .386. We made it to the regional tournament both years where our season was ultimately completed.

My Junior through super-senior years were played at the University of Central Missouri (2019-2021). My Junior year I led the team with a .444 total batting average and hitting .538 against southpaws. Our season ended in the Division 2 College World Series where we finished third in the country.

Before my senior year got cut short due to Covid, I lead-off for the Mules and hit .341 in 21 games played. Thanks to Covid however, I was fortunate enough to get to go back and play for a fifth year where I led-off the Mules batting order for the entirety of the season. Leading the MIAA in batting average (.426) as well as OBP (.494). I was fortunate to be named a D2CCA All-American as well as a Rawlings All-American. We finished second in the country, to Wingate University in the Division 2 College World series.

Hitting has and always will be my passion when it comes to baseball. To be able to inform and lead young hitters to be the best they can possibly be not only in baseball but in every facet of their life would be a dream come true for me
