



## POLICIES/PROCEDURES FOR FACILITY

### Coaches:

- Do not enter the cage area and keep players out until your scheduled time.
- It is your responsibility to make sure your players have picked up and thrown away all their trash.
- Exit the cages at your scheduled end time. Make sure all players and equipment have been removed from your assigned cages by your assigned end time. Do not go over by even five minutes.
- Please be respectful of each other's scheduled times. Time is precious for every team.

### Players:

- Treat the facility like you would your home.
- Keep walkways clear.
- Pick up after yourself; make sure trash finds the trash can.
- No writing on anything.
- Do not spit your seeds on the floor; seeds allowed in front office area only.
- If you drop something, pick it up.

### Parents:

- Please drop your player off or sit in the front office and/or bleacher area only.
- Allow the coaches to have your players' attention while at practice.
- Please save all your questions for the coaches until the end of practice in the front office area.
- Keep pathways clear for teams entering and exiting the cages.
- If you bring siblings along, please watch them while at the facility.
- If your child damages walls, tables, or any property in the facility, you are financially responsible.
- Do not allow siblings to run around facility or in cages at any time.
- Please keep siblings from playing with the soap, toilet paper, paper towels in the bathroom.
- Children are not to go through the front office desk drawers.
- Apparel that is on display is not to be played with by young children.
- Business cards in the front area are for business purposes only and approved by Darron.

**Please remember that our goal is to provide a safe and clean environment for your child to learn. Everyone needs to do his or her part in keeping the facility safe, clean, and tidy.**
