## Rower Drop Off:

- 1** The best place to drop off your rower is in the drop off zone at the Race Barricade (stay to the right) by Strawberry Mansion Drive. Rower's continue to the trailer. Drivers will then be directed to rejoin traffic up the Strawberry Mansion Drive hill.
- 2** Rowers follow the path towards the Radnor trailer. The trailer is typically located in the parking lot between the Temple University Boathouse and the St. Joe's Boathouse.

*Note: For spectators with limited mobility (not great on hills or uneven surfaces), you may drop them off here as well.*

## Parking:

- 3** Drivers continue up the hill and turn onto Edgley Drive. This is the best place to find street parking. It provides the most direct route to the Radnor Tent via Boxer's Trail. Find the Trail Marker for the Boxer's Trail as denoted on map.



- 4** Follow trail down to Kelly Drive. (A=>B) Continue to river bank and Radnor Tent is usually between the two landmarks - Painted Pole and the Painted Steps.

## Paid Parking Lots:

There are 2 paid parking lots (\$20 cash only) located on map below. You may take one of the less traveled paths from the parking lot down to the river but be advised – many are steep and involve

navigating tree roots, etc. Definitely not recommended for those unsteady on their feet or carrying items in their hands.

## Parking Shuttles:

Parking Shuttles will travel a continuous loop from the Paid Parking Lots down to the river bank. Anyone may hail the shuttle while walking. This is a great option for unsteady walkers or those not in a hurry. Build in extra time if you plan to take the shuttle.
