


## Preparation for Individual College Meetings

## Determining the "Right Fit"

Individual preferences and needs combined to form the "Right Fit" include the following:



- 1. Understanding YOUR Academics
  - a. Scheduled date to take SAT / PSAT?
  - b. Current Score
  - c. SAT Preparation Courses
  - d. Academic "needs"? (Honors,
  - e. Areas of interest, study?



- 2. Initial List of 10 25 Colleges / Universities
  - a. This "list" is just an initial step
  - b. The list evolves into 3 different indexes

- c. The process of finding the right "fit" academically, level of play, financially
- d. Understand limitations
  - i. Willingness to go outside Ohio, the region?
  - ii. Tradeoffs, Compromise: Academics, \$\$\$, Location, Student Life
- e. Ties to Colleges / Universities
  - i. Family ties includes history with particular university, past benevolent donations of funding to university from family
- f. Letters received / contacts to players from colleges / universities based on their interest in you academically or soccer
  - We now back track and contact coaches / soccer programs based on interest from college / universities
- 3. Do Your Home Work on the Internet
  - a. Investigate Colleges / Universities
    - i. Academic requirements
    - ii. Grasp of cost
    - iii. Size of School
    - iv. Look at Roster of Players
    - v. Where do they come from (clubs)?
    - vi. Experience / backgrounds? (ODP, youth national teams, awards)
    - vii. Graduation Cycle
      - 1. Your year of high school graduation
      - 2. College Graduations; how they match up with the needs of the team, position you play in year of graduation?
- 4. Contact with college programs / college coaches
  - a. Email, Introduction
  - b. Express interest in Program / school
  - c. Where the team will be playing (Showcases, FWRL) game schedules
  - d. Encourage them to see YOUR team play, see YOU play
  - e. Express an interest in learning what their needs for their team will be in YOUR YEAR OF GRADUATION.



- f. Contacts with college coaches are a NECESSITY and must be completed PRIOR TO SCHEDULED GAMES.
- g. ALL contact with college coaches must be regular with email, phone calls versus sporadic and random
- h. Need to visit unofficially a number of colleges, universities.
- 5. We come out of individual meetings with a plan that will work FOR YOU
  - a. This is a process
  - b. Where you are RIGHT NOW is your starting point
- 6. Follow Up Meetings
  - a. Where are you in Communications, College Coach Feedback, Campus Visits, Dialogue with College Coach, Director or Team Coach conversation with college coach
