

PBO Community Equipment Exchange – Official Rules

The PBO Community Equipment Exchange is designed to reduce the cost of youth baseball, promote reuse, and support our community. This event is built on fairness, respect, and good sportsmanship.

Eligibility:

- Open to registered PBO players (current season) only
- Player must be present with a parent or guardian
- Equipment is for personal use only (not for resale)
- No donation is required to receive equipment

Accepted Equipment:

We accept gently used, safe, and playable items:

- Bats
- Gloves
- Helmets
- Cleats
- Catcher's gear
- Bags

Items not meeting safety standards may be declined.

Exchange Rules:

Maximum of 4 items per player:

- 1 bat
 - 1 glove
 - 1 helmet
 - 1 pair of cleats or bag
-
- One pass through the exchange only
 - First-come, first-served
 - No holding or reserving items
 - Volunteers may assist with sizing and enforce limits
 - Item limits may be adjusted based on inventory

Donation Policy:

- Donations are encouraged but not required
- Donations may also be brought on-site during the event
- All donated items become property of PBO
- Items cannot be reclaimed once donated

Conduct:

- Participate with fairness and respect
- No resale or team collection
- Volunteers have final authority to enforce rules

Leftover Equipment:

- Remaining items will be donated to a local youth charity
