***Approval of March 2020 minutes***

- Cannizzo made the motion to approve the April meeting minutes, seconded by Santiago

***Treasurer Report (Tom Alifano)***

- Total cash on hand: \$306k
  - Subtract \$137k for outstanding invoices
  - Subtract ~\$82k for work bond account
  - Available cash balance: ~\$87k
- Turf loan balance is \$55,281; monthly payment will be reduced from \$6k to \$3300
- Collected \$130k (spring rec, travel team registrations, etc.)
- \$0 sponsorship revenue
- Potential \$100k-\$130k in registration refunds

***Cooperstown 2020 (Katie Franklin)***

- No Changes from April 2020 update; still targeted to go on Week #8 (August 3 2020)
- Paid in full (\$17,520) to All Star Village; raised \$21,820
- Swag/promotional materials have not been ordered

- ~600 players compared to 700 same time last year
- Received 15 refund requests

- Need to pay BSN invoice (~\$20k)

### ***COVID-19 Contingency Planning (Phil Confalone)***

- BW Lacrosse cancelled their 2020 spring season
- Spoke with Mayor Moenech – basketball and tennis courts may re-open; No updates on baseball or softball fields yet
- Monroe, Hopewell and Princeton rec cancelled their seasons
- Basking Ridge has NOT cancelled their rec season yet
- If rec baseball/softball is allowed, we may be able to hold a shortened season (June 15 – July 31)
- Main expenses:
  - \$30k annual liability insurances (looking into cost reduction possible)
  - \$10k salary for bookkeeper and league scheduler/administrator
