



NCLL BATTING CAGE RULES

1. All batting cage scheduling will be done through the board-appointed scheduler.
2. Batting cages are for NCLL teams and rostered players only.
3. Scheduled teams have priority for batting cage use, followed by other non-scheduled teams.
4. A manager or rostered coach must be present to use batting cages.
5. An adult with an "L" screen and all safety devices in place must operate the pitching machine.
6. At no time will anyone under eighteen (18) operate a pitching machine.
7. Pitching machines must be "OFF" when not in use.
8. Pitching machine(s), balls and all other cage gear must be put away at the end of every session.
9. The manager/coach scheduled for the cage will be responsible for the pitching machine and balls.
10. Live pitchers must use protective "L" Screens at all times.
11. No metal cleats allowed in the cage building. Tennis shoes are preferred over cleats.
12. Netted cage area limited to one (1) batter at a time. No more than two (2) people inside the netted area at any time (1 pitcher, one batter).
13. All participating players must wear batting helmets at all times when there are live batters in the cage building.
14. No food or drink in the batting cage and bownet area.
15. Spectators and players not inside the netted cage area need to stay back from the cage net and the batting/bownet stations.
16. Any abuse of batting cage rules or misuse of equipment may result in the TEAM's suspension from using the batting cage for the rest of the season.
