T-Ball Rules (Update 2/7/2024)

- 1. Home team is responsible for field setup.
- 2. Visitor team is responsible for field clean up and return all equipment to shed.
- 3. Each game will be three (3) innings long with a time limit of 90 minutes. No inning shall start after 75 minutes of play, but inning will be completed if started.
- 4. Home team shall occupy the first base "dugout" and visiting team will occupy the third base "dugout."
- 5. Each inning, both teams will bat their entire lineup.
- 6. Each team should have one parent volunteer "bench manager" to help keep the players on the bench and keep batters on deck and in proper equipment.
- 7. There can be only two (2) offensive base coaches on the field (first and third bases).
- 8. At the coach's discretion, defensive coaches may position themselves in outfield territory.
- 9. Every player bats and batting orders remain the same throughout the game.
- 10. All players from each team will be allowed on the field for defense. The infield will be a limited to four (4) standard infield players, in addition to the pitcher and catcher. The remaining players must be positioned in the outfield grass. No player will sit.
- 11. Each inning, the defensive players must play a different position than they previously played in that particular game.
- 12. Every player must wear a helmet and a cup when batting, running the bases or ion field.

- 13. The defensive catcher must wear all catchers gear.
- 14. Bats used must say Tball.
- 15. Each team must furnish one (1) new league supplied baseball per game which you can get at the snack bar.
- 16. Batters must not throw their bat. The first offense per player will only be a warning. A second offense will require the batter to sit out.
- 17. Coaches are responsible for "T" adjustments of individual batters.
- 18. The ball must travel past the 10' arc or the ball is foul.
- 19. No walks, not strikeouts.
- 20. The tee must be removed when a runner is coming in to home plate.
- 21. Home team furnishes the tee.
- 22. All balls hit to the infield will advance runners one (1) base.
- 23. All balls hit to the outfield will advance runners two (2) bases.
- 24. Half way through the season coaches will begin to use the pitch machine or have a coach pitch to the batters. At that point when a defensive play results in an out, the runner will be required to leave the field. Three outs will NOT end an inning. All players will bat each inning. i.e.; there can be 12 outs in an inning.
- 25. Score is not kept.
- 26. Stealing bases is not allowed.
- 27. Runners cannot advance until after the ball is put into play.
- 28. Have FUN!

NOTE: PLEASE DON'T FORGET TO PUT ALL EQUIPMENT AWAY AND LOCK THE SHED AFTER EACH GAME.
