DYA Basketball Scorekeepers operate the scoreboard for games in the 7th-12th grade boys & 6th-12th grade girls recreational leagues. Regular season games begin in early December and tournaments conclude in early March. Games are played at middle school and high school gymnasiums in the Dublin City School District on Saturday & Sunday afternoons and evenings. Scorekeepers also have the opportunity to work the annual DYA Travel Basketball Holiday Tournament in December.

ELIGIBILITY

The following are required to become a DYA Scorekeeper:

Grades:	8 th -12 th grade
Residency:	Must be a City of Dublin resident or Dublin City School District resident
Sign-up:	New applicants sign up through the DYA website

GAME SCHEDULING

It is the goal of the program that all scorekeepers work at least 20 games each year. Scorekeepers are typically scheduled to work 20 to 30 games per year.

- ✓ Scorekeepers submit a work availability sheet at the beginning of the season.
- ✓ Game schedules are emailed to scorekeepers and parents on a weekly basis.
- ✓ Scorekeepers (or their parents) are encouraged to keep the Coordinator aware of unavailable dates/times by email.
- ✓ If unavailable to work their scheduled games, scorekeepers are required to find a substitute.
