Any parent, guardian, guest or anyone ("Spectator") in attendance at a practice, game or league event, upon entering property that SCLL is in possession of, including any parking areas agrees to be bound by the following policy:

Any spectator in attendance at a practice, game or league event, guilty of improper conduct, including but not limited to, violation of the [Little League Sport Parent Code of Conduct](#), will be asked to leave the event site, inclusive of the parking area, by a league official and will automatically be suspended from the following practice, game and/or league event.

Refusal to comply with a league official's request to leave the event site, egregious conduct or repeat violations of this policy may result in multiple game suspensions, season forfeiture or a lifetime ban of the privilege of attending practices, games and/or league events or entering upon any property in which SCLL is in possession of, inclusive of the parking area. The authority to impose these additional penalties will be at the sole discretion of the SCLL Board of Directors.

SCLL Umpires may invoke Rule 9.01 (g) of the official Little League Playing Rules in order to assist in enforcing this by-law:

Umpires may order both teams into their dugouts and suspend play until such time as league officials deal with unruly spectators. Failure of league officials to adequately handle an unruly spectator can result in the game remaining suspended until a later date.

Following the invocation of Rule 9.01 (g) or any violation or complaint regarding violation of this by-law, the SCLL President will conduct an investigation and may propose penalties or additional penalties to the SCLL Board of Directors as outlined in this policy.

SCLL, as lessee of county property, is within our rights to issue a No Trespass order(s) and request police enforcement of the order. If such order is issued, the order will stand until notification in writing by SCLL, to the offender, of the order being terminated. The decision to issue a no trespass order or to terminate a no trespass order will be at the sole discretion of the SCLL Board of Directors.

This policy transfers to all guardians and/or guests that the parent or guardian spectator invites to the game and/or practice site. Parent and guardian spectators assume responsibility and liability for the action of their guests and are subject to the same penalties as if they violated this policy themselves.
