

2024 CHLL Intermediate Division Local Rules – Fall Ball

The following “local” rules will apply to CHLL Intermediate Division: any/all other rules will be enforced per the official Little League Baseball Rulebook.

1. There will be a maximum of four (4) runs scored per half inning. No official score will be kept except for single inning run limit calculation.
2. Pitchers will be warned for balks (without penalty), which will provide the opportunity for instruction during the dead ball time.
3. There is no MAXIMUM time limit for a game. The last inning of the game will be the first inning to begin after two hours (2:00) from the start of the game as noted by the umpire at first pitch.
4. A pitcher shall be limited to no more than two inning per game.
5. A game may not be started, or continued, with less than eight players. If only eight players are available at the beginning of, or during a game due to absence, injury, or ejection, the missing spot in the batting order shall be not an automatic out each time that missing spot in the batting order comes around during the game.
6. Teams are permitted to borrow a player from another team in the division including the opposing team to achieve a minimum of nine players. Borrowed players shall bat last and must play in the outfield.
