



## **Menomonee Falls Little League Responsible Spectator Plan**

Menomonee Falls Little League (MFL), in coordination with Little League International, wishes to promote the health of all players, coaches, umpires, volunteers and spectators. With this plan we are addressing expectations and guidelines for spectators of our games this summer. The following guidelines will be used to accomplish this goal.

1. Anyone sick or showing symptoms of being sick should stay home. Following the CDC guidelines this includes unexplained muscle aches, fever 100.4, shortness of breath, persistent cough, flu-like symptoms, etc.
2. If you, your player, or another member of your household tests positive for COVID-19, we respectfully request that you self-quarantine for two weeks and notify your coach or Player Agent so we can alert others that you may have had contact with. We will NOT divulge names or personal information, only that there was a positive test.
3. Family members with weakened or compromised immune systems should stay home to avoid any unnecessary risks.
4. All participants and spectators are not required to wear masks. Mask use is up to each family to determine what is best for their situation. Anyone with compromised immune systems or conditions that attend a game or event, are strongly encouraged to consider wearing masks.
5. Bleachers may be prohibited for spectator seating to help mitigate social distancing of the players from the dugouts. If they are roped off, do not sit there. You are encouraged to bring lawn chairs.
6. Families should sit together but maintain social distancing from other families. Seating can happen in the grassy areas around the fences on either side of the field.
7. Parents are encouraged to supply their player(s) with wipes or sanitizer in their equipment bags for use before, during or after games as necessary.
8. Social distancing is recommended. Each family will be responsible for making sure those with them are being responsible spectators and respecting the space of others. Parents may wish to accompany their children to play areas.
9. Players are encouraged to use their own personal equipment and avoid sharing. If families can afford helmets, bats and catcher's gear (only for those that intend to catch often) they should invest in this for their player(s). MFL will be loaning helmets out to those that do not have their own.
10. All shared equipment must be wiped down after the games.
11. When shopping at concessions, please honor social distancing suggestions. Our menu may be shortened this year to eliminate unnecessary waiting in line for purchases.
