How to Chalk the Ball Field Lines

You will need:

- Chalk cart
- Batter's Box Frame
- Line String (with stake)



Batter's Box:

Line up the tab of the Batter's Box frame with the short side of Home Plate.

Press frame firmly into the dirt to make an imprint.

Repeat on other side of home plate.

These are the lines to be chalked for the batter's box.





Using the Chalk Machine

Line up the front guide on the chalk machine with the line you made in the dirt

Move the OPEN lever on the handle shaft to the MIDDLE slot

Roll the chalker forward along the line. The chalk will dispense from the bottom of the chalk machine.

Pivot and continue the next line in the batter's box. Repeat on other side.





Base Lines:

Unravel the string from the holder and walk to 1st or 3rd base foul pole.

Place the stake in the ground at the bottom of the foul pole.

Walk the string back to home plate, making a straight line to the back corner of Home Plate. The string should line up with the top corner of your batters box.

Chalk along string line. Repeat for other baseline.



Please Note:

All equipment must be shared. Please return to the shed as soon as you are done.

There is only one Batter's Box Frame to be shared. Extra chalk is available in bags in the shed if the chalk machine is low/out.
