2021 AA Division

General Rules

- 1. No new inning shall start after the one hour, forty five minute mark (1:45) has elapsed.**
- 2. Teams will be comprised of 6 and 7 year-old players not drafted to AAA. Teams will be selected by the League Commissioner with the assistance of the respective coaches. Every effort should be made to even out the ability in order to create equal teams.**
- 3. Playing positions must be rotated between the infield and outfield on an inning by inning basis.**
- 4. There are no scores or standings kept and there will be no playoffs in this division. The emphasis should be placed on instruction and learning the game.**
- 5. Coaches are encouraged to go onto the field to assist players in learning positions.**
- 6. No more than (3) individuals shall be permitted on the team's bench during games. Any combination of head coach, assistant coach, and or scorekeeper – a total of 3. These 3 people will be in addition to the regular players.**
- 7. No coach or volunteer will be allowed on the field at any time without having completed the league's background check.**

Pitching

- 1. League will be 100% coach pitch**
- 2. Coaches to pitch to their own team**
- 3. If the league has enough umpires for this division, that umpire will call outs on the bases only and will not call balls and strikes. No walks and no strikeouts in this league**
- 4. Umpires will only be there if the league has enough. If no umpire is at the game coaches will call safe and out on the bases.**
- 5. If a kid swings and misses 3 times place a tee at home plate and the kid will hit off the tee to put the ball in play**

Batting

- 1. A continuous batting order shall be used for all players present at the game for the entire game.**
- 2. When in doubt the kid is SAFE, this age is about fun and not winning**

3. There is no “three out” rule. All players in the line up must bat each inning. If the ball is still in play, the last batter should continue to round the bases until he/she reaches home plate.
4. There is no bunting or half (check) swings.
5. Base runners should not leave the base until the ball has been hit.
6. Base runners may advance more than one base on a batted ball, however if the runner is tagged out, they must leave the field of play.

Stealing: There is NO STEALING allowed.
