Committee Updates

- **Merchandise/Gear**
 - All VAC athletic gear will be sold through the school Spirit Shop, managed by Lauryn Thompson, in coordination with the parish office. This creates a one-stop shop for parents while providing fundraising opportunities.
 - Commissioners are encouraged to work directly with Lauryn for any sport-specific merchandise needs to support fundraising efforts.
 - Lauryn is also available to assist with design concepts for sport-specific gear as needed.
- **Facilities**
 - Gym access is needed for Megan Torbeck for boys volleyball.
 - Requesting a comprehensive list of all access keys; will coordinate with Feldman.
- **Service**
 - Donations for Queen City Book Bank will begin mid-January, specifically for new books.
 - Collection boxes will be placed in the gyms and school office starting mid-January during boys and girls basketball season.
- **Fundraising/Social**
 - **January 23:** Trivia Night at Miami Township — 40 teams / 160 participants.

- **April 17:** Pickleball Night — includes both competitive and non-competitive divisions, with a tournament format for competitive teams.
