Hosting first round of playoff games. Discussed timing of field seeding and aeration with soccer commissioners. Bob getting multiple quotes for fill dirt for fields; dirt sand mix for winter to help fill in bad spots.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Tryouts completed, teams out in the next week. 7/8th grade tryouts for eastside league – low showing for tryouts. St. Ignatius and St. Jude are going this route so this year will be a trial run to see how it all goes. Gym time is the biggest issue; mostly getting late practice times. Learning a lot though from the east side league vs. GWAC. League starts early November, done in early January and will end season with the Visi tourney. GWAC season: practices start December with games in early January to be done in early March this year.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> New vendor being utilized this year for uniforms; hoping for quicker turnaround. Elder has increased their facility fees which has increased registration fees this year. Looking for more permanent banner placement for wrestling accolades. 	

Board Elections

- Call for anyone present who was running for an open board position; no one came forward so 3 board positions up for re-election will continue into a new 2-year term.

Reminders

- Per VAC by-laws, quotes are required for any purchases over \$5,000.
 - Bids for purchases over \$5,000 must be discussed at a board meeting with approval to move forward.
 - Anything over \$500 needs approval from the Treasurer prior to purchase.
- Safe Parish – Commissioners please remind coaches they should NOT lapse on their training. If they miss 3 quarters in a row, then a new background check must be completed at the cost of the coach
 - This happens particularly with football coaches that only coach in Fall.
- Working with the parish office more closely on scheduled weddings to avoid conflicts.

Committee Updates

- Merchandise/Gear
 - Coordinating with the Spirit Wear Store with the help of Lauryn Thompson to have a standing generic sports shirt and then have gear as season come about.
- Facilities – see *VACATIONS* section.
- Service – looking for someone to lead, but still making this happen at our big events like Baseball Night, Night Game, Thaw tournament, etc.
- Fundraising/social
 - Raising Canes dinner night in the works for the next month.
 - Sign sponsorships renewed at end of the year and hoping to have in place by boys basketball; need school maintenance to help with installation.
 - February Trivia night fundraiser in the works
 - Pickleball April 17 – working to make this more of a fundraiser this year.

VACATIONS

- Pavilion umbrellas replaced – Sept. 2025
- New Visitation fence banners– Sept. 2025 (thank you to parishioner Adam Coffaro!)
- Trimming along fence line happening week of 10/13
- Wireless Scoreboard installation – scheduled for 11/11
- Field 6 backstop replacement – Mike Bollin heading up

- Perimeter fencing in bad shape to discuss with school
- Auditorium Floor
 - Dan Ritter leading discussions about the Auditorium floor regarding life span of floor and addressing traction issues.
 - He met with 2 flooring companies to analyze the floor and get recommendations.
 - 1 recommendation - sand down and reapply with 2 sealing coats of water-based sealer: approximate 9-day process. (\$25,000 roughly including repainting)
 - 1 recommendation – suggested floor roughing and apply oil-based sealer: roughly a 4-day process. (\$3,500 to \$4,000 expense). Like yearly summer maintenance done but would be oil-based vs. water-based as done in previous years.
 - Both companies stated that we have 15 to 20 years left on the floor before it has to be replaced at a major cost.
 - Need to make a decision on the direction moving forward by February of 2026 to get on summer schedule.
 - Dan would like to do more research with other local schools and universities.
- Pavilion needs – new concessions door handle, water fountain service, restroom sinks, AED case climate-controlled box
 - Communication sent to school about the trash at the Pavilion from the school day and not athletics.
 - PTO has also reported sanitary issues with water fountain.
 - Touchless sinks not working and needs to be addressed for Spring.

Open Discussion

- Walking Path – station for bags for dog poop
 - Visi maintenance willing to purchase; discussion on concerns of them being maintained with existing trash challenges.
- Indoor Concessions – Theresa Marzheuser will be taking over to evaluate pricing and inventory. Looking to minimize expenses and to better organize sign-ups and concession processes for open and closing.
