This year's incentive for high school-age girls is their choice of a CUSTOM HFC PopSocket & HFC Croc Charms Bundle, HFC Scarf (it's a soccer thing!), HFC Water Bottle, HFC Drawstring Bag, or HFC Trucker Hat.

MARATHON GAMES FUNDRAISER

How it Works

MARATHON GAMES

- Saturday, May 16, 2026, Game Day (rain date is May 17th) at the BCSP
- 25th Annual MG (Our Silver Anniversary)
- 21st Annual Panoramic Photo
- Money raised through mailings/labels goes directly to benefit HFC soccer
- The 2025 Marathon Games raised over \$188,000, saving every team nearly \$3,000 in player fees
- This event DOES NOT benefit the Financial Aid Program. Other fundraising initiatives support our financial aid program. Marathon Games benefit **ALL** HFC player families.
- Marathon Games is our only club-wide event, a fun-packed day celebrating the end of a great year of soccer!

THE FUNDRAISER

- Labels, Labels, Labels are how we all save money!
- Please...Fill in 15 or more names and addresses on the attached label of supportive family, friends, or professionals (dentist, doctor, etc.) you know who might be willing to sponsor your child in this event. Random names from the phone book will not be accepted.
- Include the name of an individual, along with the address, if providing a potential business sponsor.
- Use black or blue ink
- Write clearly to avoid incorrect names on letters
- **Address the label in the same way the player would refer to that person (Granny, Uncle Ray, PawPaw, Miss Sue)**
- Provide complete addresses, including the zip code
- Edit the player's name on the cover sheet (to be consistent with how your child is known – this is how the letter will be signed) and circle shirt sizes (otherwise, we have to guess). Every player turning in labels gets a marathon games t-shirt.
- Players on teams with 80% participation (most teams achieve this!) will receive their choice of a custom HFC PopSocket & HFC Croc Charms Bundle, HFC Scarf (it's a soccer thing!), HFC Water Bottle, HFC Drawstring Bag, or HFC Trucker Hat.
- **Return the labels and cover sheet by Thursday, March 19.**
- Again this year, we will offer an online donation option for donors' convenience and for those without checkbooks. It also enables us to provide thank-you letters electronically.
- That's all! HFC does the rest!

NEXT STEPS

- We will print solicitation letters explaining the event and why your child is asking for their sponsorship
- We will have the player personally sign the letters at a training session or game
- We will stuff and stamp the envelopes
- We will mail thank-you letters (which serve as tax-deductible receipts) to all sponsors. ABYSA is a tax-exempt 501(c)3 Corporation
- Online donations will receive an electronic thank-you letter

THE EVENT

- All classic, intermediate, and academy players and their families are invited to game day (over 1,000 players participated in the 2025 fundraiser)
- Cookout, including burgers and sides for players, family, and their guests, is complimentary and our pleasure
- Full day of fun soccer games (not serious, just fun) and celebration

- Please return the cover sheets with the information for each of your players filled out. This is especially important for families with multiple players in the HFC program. We need this to track and give incentives.

- DO NOT INCLUDE THE NAMES OF YOUR TEAMMATES AND THEIR PARENTS ON YOUR LABEL SHEETS
