

# Frequently Asked Questions ABYSA Henderson County Rec Soccer:

### 1. Is this program being run by the Henderson County Parks and Recreation Department?

No. This program is being run by ABYSA in collaboration with Henderson County Soccer Association. Both associations are separate from the Henderson County Parks and Recreation Department. ### 2. How do I register to play ABYSA soccer in Henderson County

You will follow all the same registration steps as listed in the 'How to Register' help section, but you will select 'Henderson County' as the county program you would like to register for in the 'Player Information' section.

# 3. Will the practices and games be in Henderson County?

Teams will practice in Henderson County. As many games as possible will be in Henderson County. If there are not enough Henderson County teams in an age group to provide appropriate games, then we will mix in some Buncombe County teams and there will be some games in Henderson County and some games in Buncombe County.

## 4. Where will my child practice and on what days?

We will do our best to form teams geographically. After our pre-season coaches meeting, coaches will begin to schedule their practice day, time and location with us. During the following week, coaches are asked to contact the families on their team to invite them to the first team practice on the at least one week before your first game.

## 5. Does my 4U-6U player have practices during the week like the older age groups?

No. These age groups do not have a practice during the week. They have a combined practice and game, within a one-hour time slot every Saturday.
