## Whew! I've registered! Now what happens?

### **What's the Board doing?**

Immediately after the last registration date, your Region Board begins the process of putting the teams together for the upcoming season. When this is completed, the uniforms will be ordered and the coaches will be notified.

### **When do the coaches get their teams?**

Coaches should expect to receive their team rosters in *September 2, 2015*

### **When do the players get called?**

Teams may begin practice on or after *September 8, 2015*. The coaches will call the players after the mandatory September 2, 2015 coach/parent/referee meeting. They will give you all the information you will need in regards to practice times and location.

### **It's after Sept. 6, and my child has not been called.**

#### **What do I do?**

Please do not panic if you see teams practicing and your child has not been called. Not all teams begin practice at the same time. The very young teams, in particular, do not always begin practice on *September 8, 2015*. Also some coaches may be out of town. If your child has not been called by

### **What else does my child need?**

The registration fee includes: complete uniform (jersey, shorts, socks) supplemental accident insurance, field usage and awards.

In addition, you will need to obtain shoes. Shoes may NOT have a "center" toe cleat. A "center" toe cleat is a single cleat in the front middle of the shoe. A "center" toe cleat is considered a safety violation. The referee will not allow a player to participate in a game if the player's shoes have a "center" toe cleat. All commercially available soccer shoes are acceptable. Shin guards, a soccer ball U4-U8 size 3, U10-U12 size 4, and U14-U19 size 5 and a water bottle.

### **How often are practices and games?**

Practices are held twice a week (field and times to be determined by your child's coach). Games will be on Saturdays with the first game on *September 26th 2015* Games will be held at a field in *Saguaro Ranch Park or Glendale Community College*. Game fields for some in the older divisions may be *located throughout the valley*.

### **Refund Policy?**

Players withdrawing prior to *the first game* will be issued a full refund less a \$20 processing fee. All requests for a refund must be submitted in writing and accompanied by a self-addressed stamped envelope. Mail to *P.O. Box 11413 Glendale, AZ 85318*
