26th Annual AYSO Cactus Classic Open Invitational Tournament Team Invitation



AYSO Region 310 is proud to invite your team to the 26th Annual AYSO Cactus Classic Open Invitational Tournament

- Scope:** AYSO Open Invitational – open to AYSO teams from all Sections and Non AYSO Teams.
- When:** March 5-6, 2016
- Where:** The tournament will be held at the Westside Sports Complex. Parking is \$5.00 dollars per day. No pets are allowed at fields.
- Who:** AYSO and Non-AYSO boys and girls teams in age divisions: U-16/U-19 (11v11) 18 players max, U-14 (11v11) 15 players max. U-12 (9v9) 12 players max. and U-10 (7v7) 10 players max. All players must have been registered to play in their organizations just completed primary season. Guest players will be allowed (3 maximum per team). Co-ed teams will be accepted in boys' divisions only.
- What:** Pool play tournament. Each team will be guaranteed 3 games in pool play. The top teams will advance to the medal round on Sunday afternoon. Pool Play games will be as follows: (80 min. for U-16/U-19, 60 min. for U-14, 50 min for U-12, and 40 min for U-10) and Medal round games will be: (90 min. for U-16/U-19, 70 min. for U-14, 60 min for U-12, and 50 min for U-10).
- Why:** The Cactus Classic Open Invitational Tournament is being conducted as a fundraiser by Region 310 to raise funds Scholarships, Equipment, and Marketing
- Awards:** All players and 2 coaches per team will receive a tournament t-shirt and pin. All players on the 1st, 2nd, 3rd, & 4th place teams will receive a medal. All U10 teams not placing will receive a Participation medal. Sportsmanship medals will be given to teams that receive the highest points in each division.
- Entry Fee, Refunds:** \$425 for U-12 thru U-19 and \$400 for U-10. A full refund will be issued if tournament is canceled and cannot be rescheduled. If a team withdraws 30 or more days before the tournament, a full refund is given. Within 30 days of the tournament, no refund is provided unless a replacement team is found.
- Referee Deposit, Refunds:** \$150, refundable within 14 days of the tournament, if referee assignments have been completed. Each team is asked to provide a qualified 3-person referee team to cover 3 games during the tournament. Partial refunds will be given based upon the number of game slots completed.
- Rules:** A full set of tournament rules are posted on the tournament website.
- Acceptance:** The application deadline is February 5, 2016. All teams will be notified within 48 hrs of the application deadline or receipt of application (whichever is latest) as to their status. Teams that are not accepted will be given the option to have their complete application returned or to be placed on the waiting list.
- How:** Team entry applications and all necessary forms are available on the tournament website. Please send 1 Region / Organization check to cover both the Team Entry and Referee fees, along with the tournament application, referee information form, and team roster to the Tournament Registrar address below. Regional Commissioner or Organization President/Registrar must sign application, team roster, and team rating form. Appropriate referee administrator must sign referee information form.
