  - Stafford St. Paddy's tournament in March (<u>all teams</u>)
    \*All teams participate, and parents volunteer+
- League games played on Saturdays and Sundays

+ St. Paddy's Tournament – all travel families expected to volunteer a few hours that weekend as the host club (Field Marshal, Merchandise Sales). This Tournament funds our College Scholarship and Financial Aid programs.
