

Youth Board Members Guidelines Updated 11/7/22

Purpose: The purpose of this document is to give guidelines on the participation of youth board members with our league. As a youth serving organization, the LTBBL Board recognized the importance of involving youth on our board as it allows our Board to hear the opinions from youth. It also allows the youth board member the opportunity to experience board level participation and to grow in his/her community service experience.

Youth Board Member Requirements:

- 1. We will allow up to 14 youth board members per fiscal year (July 1 to June 30).
- 2. Youth board member terms will be renewable 1 year terms.
- 3. The Youth board member must be a high school student living in Lawrence Township or attending a Lawrence Township school.
- 4. Youth must have access to adequate transportation in order to participate (i.e. able to drive or parent is committed to transporting them).
- 5. Must be sponsored by a current Board member and must be approved by a majority of the Board.
- 6. Youth Board member must maintain a 2.5 GPA and be a student in good standing at his/her school.

Youth Board Member Duties:

- 1. Attend Board meetings as a voting board member (usually 2-3 board meetings/year)
- 2. Serve as an active member on a committee (but not in the capacity as a committee chairperson)
- 3. Be assigned to game day board member duty (i.e. supervise scorer's table). Scheduling will be flexible to take into account if the youth board member is playing in our high school league or has other outside commitments (i.e. school activities).
- 4. Assist in all other general board duty events including registration, evaluation, picture day, Championship Saturday and other activities.
