## Field Marshall Duties

- Check in at the volunteer/referee tent prior to your shift.
- All Field Marshalls wear (provided) orange vest to designate yourselves on the field during your assignment.
- Make sure that you note the game start times for the field that you are marshaling during your shift.

### 20 minutes prior to the scheduled game start

1. Obtain Game Card from Coach - Make sure it is properly filled-out and stamped with approval for tournament check-in (taken care of at the main tournament check-in area).
2. Check in the team players
  - a. Notice Jersey Colors. If colors are the same or TOO similar, the home team must wear pinnies
  - b. Each player should have their hand stamped signifying that they have been checked in for the tournament.
  - c. No jewelry- NO EARRINGS, BRACELETS, NECKLACES, WATCHES, WRIST BANDS
  - d. Medical Alert Bracelets are ok**
  - e. No hard ties, barrettes, pins in hair
  - f. Shin guards are on and COMPLETELY covered with socks
  - g. Socks outside of shin guards, not inside and folded over
  - h. Check cleats – there should be no toe cleat (No baseball shoes)
  - i. No hard casts or splints
  - j. Check for long fingernails (either cut or cover with gloves)
3. Make sure referees knows the length of game:
  - a. U14 = 25 minute halves
  - b. U12 = 25 minute halves
  - c. U10 = 20 minute halves
4. Provide Center Referee with:
  - a. Sportsmanship medals – 1 for each team
  - b. Game cards

## At game completion:

1. Collect game cards from the referees at the completion of the match.
  - a. Make sure score is clear and winner is indicated.
  - b. Ask if there were any YELLOW or RED cards - mark on appropriate card
  - c. Referees need to print their names legibly
  - d. Coaches need to verify score with a signature

## Other activities:

1. Help keep games ON TIME
2. Help keep sidelines respectful.
  - a. If you encounter any unruly fans or notice behavior not in line with AYSO philosophies, please reach out to the Head Field Marshall(s) at the volunteer/referee tent for assistance.
  - b. Periodically check bathrooms and site for trash and attention to cleanliness

If you need any help with Field Marshal Duties please do not hesitate to return to the main volunteer tent or send someone to the main volunteer tent to solicit help from a Board member. All Board members will be designated at the Tournament – wearing their Board Member apparel.
