

Playing Up / Playing Down Request Form

As a general rule, Stewards of the Game does not allow players to "play-up" or "play down" in an age division above or below their actual age (as of April 30). The only exception to "playing up" will be those rare instances where a player's skill level is so advanced that they would clearly dominate the game at their age level or put their peers in harm's way on the field. The only exception for "playing down" will be instances where there is a high probability of a player being severely injured or embarrassed if they were to play with kids their own age.

Any exception to this rule must be approved by the Age Level Coordinator (ALC) for their age division, the ALC for the age division they wish to play in and the Director of Baseball for Stewards of the Game.
